AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE AND RE-ENACT SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 166 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 188 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 166 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled:

"An ordinance of the City of Las Vegas regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, demolition, conversion, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, and maintenance, of all buildings and/or structures in the City of Las Vegas; providing for the issuance of permits, and collection of fees therefor; providing penalties for the violation thereof; declaring and establishing fire zones; repealing ordinances Nos. 144-27-59-61 and 72 of the City of Las Vegas and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," as amended by ordinance No. 188 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled:

"An ordinance to amend, revise, and re-enact Section 3 of ordinance No. 166 of the City of Las Vegas, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," shall be and the same is hereby amended, revised and re-enacted to read as follows:

That the entire incorporated area of the City of Las Vegas is hereby declared to be and is hereby established as a Fire District and said Fire District shall be known and designated as Fire Zones 2 and 3, and each such zone shall include such territory or portions of said city as illustrated, outlined and designated on a certain map on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas, being marked and designated as "Map showing Fire Zones, City of Las Vegas, Nev. as amended in connection with Ordinance No. 188 of the said City", which is hereby adopted as the fire zoning map of the said City of Las Vegas for the application of the regulations included in the "Uniform Building Code, 1930 Edition, published May, 1930, by Pacific Coast Building Officials' Conference", except that lots numbered eleven (11) to seventeen (17) inclusive in Block numbered seven (7) in Hawkin's Addition, and Lot numbered six (6) in Block numbered three (3) in Buck's Subdivision shall be and hereby are incorporated in Fire Zone 3 instead of in Fire Zone 2, said zones are shown on said map."
