

ORDINANCE NO. 2304

2 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLEANING OF LOTS WITHIN
3 THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AND PROVIDING PEN-
4 ALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, and REPEALING ALL
5 ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH,
6 AND PARTICULARLY REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 91 OF THE CITY
7 OF LAS VEGAS, APPROVED MARCH 15, 1922.

9 The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas,
10 do ordain as follows:

11 SECTION 1. Every person or persons owning a lot or
12 lots within the limits of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, State
13 of Nevada, are hereby required to clean the debris, rubbish, garbage,
14 weeds over four inches in height, and brush, from the same on or before
15 the 30th day of April of each year, commencing with the year 1938;
16 and thereafter also to clean such lot or lots of debris, rubbish,
17 garbage, weeds over four inches in height, and brush, within ten
18 days after notice, either verbal or in writing, given to such person
19 or persons by the Commissioner of Streets and Public Property in the
20 City of Las Vegas. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of
21 this section or with the requirements of such notice shall be a mis-
22 demeanor, and every person found guilty of violating any provision
23 of this Section or any requirement of any such notice shall, upon
24 conviction thereof, be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more
25 than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) or imprisoned in the City Jail
26 until such fine is paid at the rate of not exceeding one day for
27 each Two Dollars of such fine in case such fine is not paid, or by
28 imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed three months or by both
29 such fine and imprisonment.

30 PROVIDED, that when there shall exist debris, rubbish,
31 garbage, weeds over four inches in height, or brush upon a lot or
32 lots owned by a non-resident of the City of Las Vegas contrary to
the provisions of this ordinance, a written notice shall be posted

1 by or at the instance of such Commissioner of Streets and Public
2 Property in a conspicuous place on each such lot in view of the
3 public, notifying the owner or owners of said lot or lots, to clean
4 the same within ten days from the date of posting of such notice;
5 and in the event of the failure of such owner or owners to clean
6 such lot or lots within ten days after the date of posting such
7 notice as aforesaid, the cleaning of said lot or lots shall be done
8 on behalf of said City of Las Vegas by the Commissioner of Streets
9 and Public Property thereof and the cost thereof shall become a
10 debt in favor of said City of Las Vegas against the owner or owners
11 of such lots or lot so cleaned, and the amount thereof may be re-
12 covered from the owner or owners of such lot or lots in a civil act-
13 ion to be brought and prosecuted in any court of competent juris-
14 diction.

15 SECTION 2. Ordinance Number 91 of the City of Las
16 Vegas entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLEANING OF LOTS
17 WITHIN THE LIMITS OF CLARK'S LAS VEGAS TOWNSITE IN THE CITY OF LAS
18 VEGAS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEAL-
19 ING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH,"
20 Approved March 15, 1922, is hereby expressly repealed and all other
21 ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance
22 are hereby repealed.

23 SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to
24 have this Ordinance published in the LAS VEGAS ~~APR~~
25 REVIEW-JOURNAL, a newspaper, printed and published in the
26 City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, for a period of two weeks,
27 that is to say, once each week for a period of two weeks.



ORDINANCE NO. 234
 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLEARING OF LOTS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND PARTICULARLY REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 91 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, APPROVED MARCH 15, 1922.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:
SECTION 1. Every person or persons owning a lot or lots within the limits of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, State of Nevada, are hereby required to clean the debris, rubbish, garbage, weeds, over four inches in height, and brush from the same on or before the 30th day of April of each year, commencing with the year 1938, and thereafter also to clean such lot or lots of debris, rubbish, garbage, weeds over four inches in height, and brush within ten days after notice, either verbal or in writing, given to such person or persons by the Commissioner of Streets and Public Property in the City of Las Vegas. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this section or with the requirements of such notice shall be a misdemeanor, and every person found guilty of violating any provision of this Section or any requirement of any such notice shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) or imprisoned in the City Jail until such time is paid at the rate of not exceeding one day for each Two Dollars of such fine. In case such fine is not paid or by imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed three months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. **PROVIDED,** that when there shall exist debris, rubbish, garbage, weeds over four inches in height, or brush upon a lot or lots owned by a non-resident of the City of Las Vegas contrary to the provisions of this ordinance, a written notice shall be posted by or at the instance of such Commissioner of Streets and Public Property in a conspicuous place on each such lot in view of the public, notifying the owner or owners of said lot or lots to clean the same within ten days from the date of posting of such notice; and in the event of the failure of such owner or owners to clean such lot or lots within ten days after the date of posting of such notice as aforesaid, the cleaning of said lot or lots shall be done on behalf of said City of Las Vegas by the Commissioner of Streets and Public Property thereof and the cost thereof shall become a debt in favor of said City of Las Vegas against the owner or owners of such lots or lots so cleaned, and the amount thereof may be recovered from the owner or owners of such lot or lots in a civil action to be brought and prosecuted in any court of competent jurisdiction.
