

ORDINANCE NO. 225

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONMENT AND VACATION OF A PARCEL OF LAND HERETOFORE CONSTITUTING A PORTION OF SOUTH MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain:

Section 1. That parcel of land lying between Garces Street and Gass Street and immediately westerly of South Main Street, as the said Main Street is now constructed, which said parcel of land was heretofore used as a portion of South Main Street as formerly constructed but having been abandoned upon the construction of South Main Street as it now exists, which said parcel of land is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west property line of South Main Street 128 feet Southerly from the northwest corner of the South Addition to the City of Las Vegas, as shown by map thereof on file in Book 1 of Plats, page 51, in the office of the County Recorder of Clark County, Nevada;

Thence following the Westerly line of said street as now constructed as follows: Southerly on a curve of 420 feet radius to the left a distance of 244.3 feet;

Thence South-50°26' East 112.5 feet to an intersection with the Northeasterly line of Lot "A" of said South Addition, which said point is 40 feet North 17°15' West from the Southeast corner of said Lot "A";

Thence North 17°15' West 186.26 feet along the Northeasterly line of said Lot "A" to the North corner of said Lot "A";

Thence North 27°45' East with the West line of said Main Street, as shown by plat of said South Addition, 192 feet to the point of beginning.

is hereby abandoned and vacated as a street or public thoroughfare.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is passed as an Emergency Ordinance and the same shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and publication as required by law.

This Emergency Ordinance was read aloud in full for the first time, proposed and considered and voted upon this 27th day of May, 1937.

Vote on the passage of this ordinance was Commissioners Down, Krause, Marble and Perry and His Honor the Mayor voting aye. Noes, none. Absent none.

Introduced and passed on this 27th day of May, 1937, and was thereafter published in the Las Vegas Evening Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas for two consecutive weeks.

Thence following the Westerly line of said street as now constructed as follows: Southerly on a curve of 420 feet radius to the left a distance of 244.3 feet;

Thence South 5° 25' East 112.5 feet to an intersection with the Northeasterly line of Lot "A" of said South Addition, which said point is 40 feet North 17° 15' West from the Southeast corner of said Lot "A";

Thence North 17° 15' West 136.26 feet along the Northeasterly line of said Lot "A" to the North corner of said Lot "A";

Thence North 27° 45' East with the West line of said Main Street, as shown by plat of said South Addition, 192 feet to the point of beginning.

is hereby abandoned and vacated as a street or public thoroughfare.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is passed as an Emergency Ordinance and the same shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and publication as required by law.

This Emergency Ordinance was read aloud in full for the first time, proposed and considered and voted upon this 27th day of May, 1937.
