2 AN ORDINANCE EMPOWERING, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE EX-OFFICIO  
3 CITY ASSESSOR OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF  
4 NEVADA, TO LEVY A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF MAKING  
5 CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS BY GRADING, FOR AND  
6 THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALL OIL BOUND PAVEMENT AND CONCRETE CURBS AND  
7 GUTTERS ON CERTAIN STREETS AND PORTIONS OF STREETS IN THE CITY OF  
8 LAS VEGAS, ACCORDING TO THE PLATS, DIAGRAMS AND ESTIMATES OF COST  
9 THEREOF ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF LAS  
10 VEGAS, DESCRIBING DEFINITELY THE LOCATION OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS,  
11 STATING THE AMOUNTS OF SAID ASSESSMENTS AND DESIGNATING THE LOTS,  
12 PARCELS OF LAND AND PREMISES TO BE ASSESSED, ACCORDING TO BENEFITS,  
13 PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENT BONDS FOR THE  
14 PAYMENT THEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

15 The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do  
16 ordain:

17 Section 1. For the purpose of defraying a portion of the  
18 costs of making certain improvements in the City of Las Vegas,  
19 by grading for and constructing oil bound gravel pavement and con-  
20 crete curbs and gutters, according to the plats, diagrams and  
21 estimates of cost heretofore prepared, and adopted by the Board of  
22 Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, and on file in the office  
23 of the City Clerk of said City; the Ex-Officio City Assessor of  
24 the City of Las Vegas is hereby empowered, authorized and directed  
25 to forthwith levy the special assessment in the amount hereinafter  
26 specified, against the owners and upon the lots, lands and premises,  
27 hereinafter designated and described according to benefits. Said  
28 special assessment shall be levied upon the taxable lots, lands and  
29 premises, hereinafter designated and described according to benefits.  
30 Said special assessment shall be levied upon the taxable lots, prop-  
31 erty and premises situate in the special assessment district created  
32 according to the terms of an order made with respect to the said  
improvements on the fourth day of December, 1936, benefitted by  
said improvements proportionately to the benefits received; provid-  
ed, however, that in no case shall the said Ex-Officio Assessor  
levy any special assessment upon any such lots, lands or premises,  
exceeding fifty percent (50%), of the value of such lots, lands  
or premises as last before valued and assessed for State and County  
taxation in the County Tax Roll; but such costs over and above and  
exceeding that percent shall be paid from the General Fund of the  
City of Las Vegas.

Section 2. The Ex-Officio City Assessor shall assess the  
taxable lots, property and premises situate in the special assess-  
ment district, created by the order of the Board of Commissioners  
of the City of Las Vegas December 4, 1936, benefitted by said  
improvements proportionately to the benefits received, that is to  
say, such Ex-Officio Assessor shall assess upon each lot, parcel  
of land or premises such relative portion of the whole sum to be  
levied as shall be proportionate to the estimated benefit resulting  
to such lot, parcel of land or premises from said improvement.

Section 3. In levying the assessments as in this Ordinance  
provided, the Ex-Officio Assessor shall prepare a Special Assess-  
ment Roll therefor, and after he shall have completed the Assess-  
ment Roll, he shall report the same to the Board of Commissioners  
as provided for by law and upon receiving such report and Special  
Assessment Roll, the said Roll shall be numbered and filed in the  
office of the City Clerk, and the Board of Commissioners shall  
cause notice thereof to be published for at least two weeks in some

1 newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, of the filing of  
2 the same with the City Clerk; and appointing a time when the  
3 Board of Commissioners and the Ex-Officio Assessor will meet  
4 to review the assessment, and any person objecting thereto may be  
5 heard, or any person objecting to the assessments, may file  
6 his or her objection thereto in writing with the City Clerk.

7 Section 4. At the time appointed for the purpose of  
8 reviewing said assessments and considering any objections thereto  
9 made at said time or filed in writing, the Board of Commissioners  
10 and said Ex-Officio Assessor shall meet and then, or at some  
11 adjourned meeting, review said assessments, and will hear any  
12 objections to said assessments, which have been made or filed  
13 as aforesaid by any person deeming himself aggrieved thereby,  
14 and will decide upon the same as to any assessment, or descrip-  
15 tion of the premises appearing necessary therein, and will  
16 confirm it as reported or as corrected, or will refer the assess-  
17 ment back to the Ex-Officio Assessor for revision or annul it  
18 and direct a new assessment to be made; when said assessment  
19 shall be confirmed, the City Clerk shall make an endorsement  
20 upon the Roll showing said confirmation and the same shall be  
21 final and conclusive; the City Clerk shall then deliver the  
22 same to the County Assessor, acting Ex-Officio City Assessor,  
23 with his certificate of confirmation, and the County Assessor,  
24 acting Ex-Officio City Assessor, shall thereupon record said  
25 assessment roll in his office and append thereto his certificate  
26 of the date of recording. Said roll when so endorsed and record-  
27 ed, shall be prima facie evidence in all Courts and Tribunals  
28 of the regularity of the proceedings, preliminary to the  
29 making thereof, and of the validity of said Assessment and Ass-  
30 essment Roll.

31 Section 5. Upon the confirmation and recording of the  
32 said Assessments and Assessment Roll as by the Charter of the  
33 City of Las Vegas provided, the Assessments shall be at once  
34 due and payable, and from the date of said confirmation and  
35 recording, shall constitute and be a lien upon the lot or  
36 parcel of land and premises assessed, together with the legal  
37 interest thereon, and shall be charged against the persons and  
38 properties until paid.

39 Section 6. The several lots and premises, together  
40 with their location, the name of the present owner, and the  
41 approximate amounts to be assessed thereon, are as follows:



**ORDINANCE No. 222**

An Ordinance Empowering, Authorizing and Directing the Ex-Officio City Assessor of the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, to Levy a Special Assessment to Defray the Costs of Making Certain Improvements in the City of Las Vegas by Grading for and the Construction of All Oil Bound Pavement and Concrete Curbs and Gutters on Certain Streets and Portions of Streets in the City of Las Vegas, According to the Plans, Diagrams and Estimates of Cost Thereof on File in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas, Describing Definitely the Location of Said Improvements, Stating the Amounts of Said Assessments and Designating the Lots, Parcels of Land and Premises to be Assessed, According to Benefits, Providing for the Issuance of Special Assessment Bonds for the Payment Thereof, and Other Matters Relating Thereto.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain:

Section 1. For the purpose of defraying a portion of the costs of making certain improvements in the City of Las Vegas, by grading for and constructing oil bound gravel pavement and concrete curbs and gutters, according to the plans, diagrams and estimates of cost heretofore prepared, and adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, and on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City; the Ex-Officio City Assessor of the City of Las Vegas is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to forthwith levy the special assessment in the amount hereinafter specified, against the owners and upon the lots, lands and premises, hereinafter designated and described according to benefits. Said special assessment shall be levied upon the taxable lots, lands and premises hereinafter designated and described according to benefits. Said special assessment shall be levied upon the taxable lots, property and premises situate in the special assessment district created according to the terms of an order made with respect to the said improvements on the fourth day of December, 1936, benefitted by said improvements proportionately to the benefits received; provided, however, that in no case shall the said Ex-Officio Assessor levy any special assessment upon any such lots, lands or premises, exceeding fifty percent (50%) of the value of such lots, lands or premises as last before valued and assessed for State and County taxation in the County Tax Roll; but such costs over and above and exceeding that percent shall be paid from the General Fund of the City of Las Vegas.

Section 2. The Ex-Officio City Assessor shall assess the taxable lots, property and premises situate in the special assessment district, created by the order of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas December 4, 1936, benefitted by said improvements proportionately to the benefits received, that is to say, such Ex-Officio Assessor shall assess upon each lot, parcel of land or premises such relative portion of the whole sum to be levied as shall be proportionate to the estimated benefit resulting to such lot, parcel of land or premises from said improvement.

Section 3. In levying the assessments as in this Ordinance provided, the Ex-Officio Assessor shall prepare a Special Assessment Roll therefor, and after he shall have completed the Assessment Roll, he shall report the same to the Board of Commissioners as provided for by law and upon receiving such report and Special Assessment Roll, the said Roll shall be numbered and filed in the office of the City Clerk, and the Board of Commissioners shall cause notice thereof to be published for at least two weeks in some newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, of the filing of the same with the City Clerk, and appointing a time when the Board of Commissioners and the Ex-Officio Assessor will meet to review the assessment, and any person objecting thereto may be heard, or any person objecting to the assessments, may file his or her objection thereto in writing with the City Clerk.

Section 4. At the time appointed for the purpose of reviewing said assessments and considering any objections thereto made at said time or filed in writing, the Board of Commissioners and said Ex-Officio Assessor shall meet and then, or at some adjourned meeting, review said assessments, and will hear any objections to said assessments, which have been made or filed as aforesaid by any person deeming himself aggrieved thereby, and will decide upon the same as to any assessment, or description of the premises appearing necessary therein, and will confirm it as reported or as corrected, or will refer the assessment back to the Ex-Officio Assessor for revision or annul it, and direct a new assessment to be made; when said assessment shall be confirmed, the City Clerk shall make an endorsement upon the Roll showing said confirmation and the same shall be final and conclusive; the City Clerk shall then deliver the same to the County Assessor, acting Ex-Officio City Assessor, with his certificate of confirmation, and the County Assessor, acting Ex-Officio City Assessor, shall thereupon record said assessment roll in his office and append thereto his certificate of the date of recording. Said roll when so endorsed and recorded, shall be prima facie evidence in all Courts and Tribunals of the regularity of the proceedings, preliminary to the making thereof, and of the validity of said Assessment and Assessment Roll.

Section 5. Upon the confirmation and recording of the said Assessments and Assessment Roll as by the Charter of the City of Las Vegas provided, the Assessments shall be at once due and payable, and from the date of said confirmation and recording, shall constitute and be a lien upon the lot or parcel of land and premises assessed, together with the legal interest thereon, and shall be charged against the persons and properties until paid.

Section 6. The several lots and premises, together with their location, the name of the present owner, and the approximate amounts to be assessed thereon, are as follows:

Section 7. The total approximate amount to be levied and collected as Special Assessment against the several lots and premises herebefore designated and described for the purpose aforesaid, is as follows, to wit: **Thirty-five Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty-two Dollars and ninety-nine cents \$35,362.99.**

Section 8. All assessments when due and payable as aforesaid, shall be paid to the County Treasurer and Ex-Officio Tax Receiver of the County of Clark, State of Nevada, and Ex-Officio Treasurer and Tax Receiver of the City of Las Vegas, who shall place the same in what shall be known as "Las Vegas 1937 Improvement District No. 3 Fund"; and no portion thereof shall be paid out of said Treasury, except upon claim duly allowed by the said Board of Commissioners for the purpose of defraying the cost and expense of making said improvements as aforesaid, and for no other purpose until the same is fully paid, provided, however, that if it becomes necessary to draw upon the General Fund of the City of Las Vegas, for the purpose of defraying any part of the cost and expense of making any of the said improvements as in this Ordinance contained, that the said General Fund of the City of Las Vegas, shall be reimbursed by funds transferred from the said Las Vegas 1937 Improvement District No. 3 Fund to the extent of the amount drawn from the General Fund as soon as said Improvement Fund shall be in condition to permit the transfer.

Section 9. That if, after the expiration of fifty days from the date of the confirmation and recording of said Special Assessment Roll, as in this Ordinance contained, there shall remain due and unpaid, any of the said special assessments as contained in said Roll, the said Board of Commissioners, within a reasonable time thereafter, shall by Ordinance provide for the issuance of bonds for the amount of the unpaid assessments, in accordance with the terms and provisions of "An Act to authorize municipalities to issue bonds for the purpose of paying the cost of municipal improvements for which special assessments are levied," approved March 13, 1909, as amended, and also in conformity with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Las Vegas.

Section 10. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its publication and final passage.

The City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in the Las Vegas Evening Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, for a period of once a week for two consecutive weeks, immediately following its first reading.
