ORDINANCE NO. 3730

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ANIMALS; AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 38, SECTION 40, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY EXEMPTING POTBELLIED PIGS FROM THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED THEREIN; BY ADDING NEW SECTIONS TO SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER PROVIDING THAT POTBELLIED PIGS ELIGIBLE FOR OWNERSHIP PURSUANT TO SAID EXEMPTION BE OF CERTAIN WEIGHT AND SIZE; BE NEUTERED OR SPAYED; BE LIMITED TO SINGLE FAMILY DETACHED RESIDENCES; BE REGISTERED ANNUALLY BY ITS OWNER UPON PAYMENT OF A PRESCRIBED FEE; LIMITING OWNERSHIP TO ONE POTBELLIED PIG; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Eliminates the requirements that a person desiring to have a potbellied pig must first secure a special permit for wild animals, and that said animal must be maintained on a parcel of land not less than twenty-five acres in area and not within two hundred fifty feet from any residence other than his own.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 7, Chapter 38, Section 40, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.38.040: (A) No person without a special permit first obtained from the Animal Regulation Officer shall own, keep, possess, or maintain hogs or pigs on any parcel of land.

(B) No person shall, in any event, keep any hogs or pigs on any parcel of land which is less than twenty-five acres in area and within two hundred fifty feet of any residence other than his own.

(C) The provisions of Subsections (A) and (B) do not apply to those persons who own, keep, possess, or maintain a potbellied pig at a detached single family residence

1 in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter.

2 SECTION 2: Title 7, Chapter 38, of the Municipal Code of the City  
3 of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a section thereto reading as  
4 follows:

5 Potbellied pigs maintained, possessed or kept in a detached single family  
6 residence must:

7 (A) Weigh not in excess of 120 pounds;

8 (B) Be not in excess of 22 inches in height;

9 (C) Be registered either with the Potbellied Pig Registry Service, Inc.,  
10 Lakeville, IN., or other nationally recognized registry for potbellied  
11 pigs;

12 (D) Be appropriately vaccinated; and

13 (E) Be neutered or spayed.

14 SECTION 3: Title 7, Chapter 38, of the Municipal Code of the City  
15 of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a section thereto reading as  
16 follows:

17 (A) Owners of a potbellied pig maintained, possessed or kept in a  
18 detached single family residence must license said animal annually with the City, and at the time  
19 of licensing must:

20 (1) Pay a \$100.00 annual licensing fee.

21 (2) Submit proof that said animal is registered in accordance with the  
22 provisions of Section 2.

23 (B) The license required in Subsection (A) shall be obtained within thirty  
24 days after the potbellied pig attains the age of four months, or within thirty days after first  
25 bringing the potbellied pig into the City.

26 SECTION 4: Title 7, Chapter 38, of the Municipal Code of the City

1 of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a section thereto reading as  
2 follows:

3 A maximum of one potbellied pig may be maintained, possessed or kept  
4 at a detached single family residence.

5 SECTION 5: Title 7, Chapter 38, of the Municipal Code of the City  
6 of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a section thereto reading as  
7 follows:

8 (A) Potbellied pigs maintained, possessed or kept at detached single  
9 family residences must be vaccinated for brucellosis and pseudorabies and receive the required  
10 boosters against said diseases in accordance with customary veterinarian standards.

11 (B) Vaccinations, other than brucellosis and pseudorabies, may be  
12 required of potbellied pigs according to veterinarian recommendation, but only upon adequate  
13 notice to such person owing, harboring, keeping, possessing, or maintaining said animal.

14 (C) Every veterinarian who vaccinates a potbellied pig is required to  
15 fulfill the same requirements pertaining to the issuance of a tag and certificate of vaccination as  
16 is required by LVMC 7.12.040 in situations involving the vaccination of a dog or cat.

17 SECTION 6: Title 7, Chapter 38, of the Municipal Code of the City  
18 of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a section thereto reading as  
19 follows:


20 The general provisions of LVMC Title 7, Chapters 8 and 12 pertaining to  
21 the licensing and vaccination of a dog or cat, and the administration and enforcement thereof,  
22 unless in conflict, inconsistent or superseded by the provisions of Chapter 38 of said Title, shall  
23 apply to potbellied pigs being maintained, possessed or kept at a detached single family residence.


24 SECTION 7: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,  
25 sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be  
26 unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision

1 shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part  
2 thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have  
3 passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof  
4 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,  
5 sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

6 SECTION 8: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections,  
7 subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City  
8 of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



7.38.040: (A) No person without a special permit first obtained from the Animal Regulation Officer shall own, keep, possess, or maintain hogs or pigs on any parcel of land.

(B) No person shall, in any event, keep any hogs or pigs on any parcel of land which is less than twenty-five acres in area and within two hundred fifty feet of any residence other than his own.

(C) The provisions of Subsections (A) and (B) do not apply to those persons who own, keep, possess, or maintain potbellied pigs.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part

3 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,

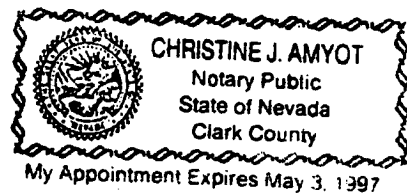

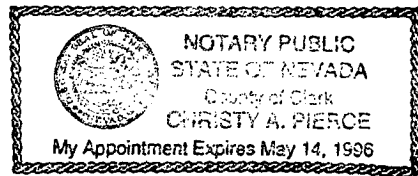

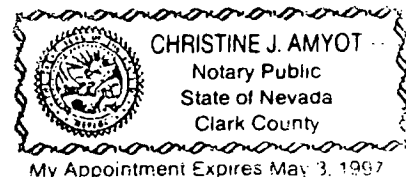
