

ORDINANCE 284

1 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE, AND RE-ENACT SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE  
2 NO. 166 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AS AMENDED, AND TO REPEAL ALL  
ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

3 The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, do ordain  
4 as follows:


5 Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 166 of the City of Las  
6 Vegas, entitled: "An Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas regulating  
7 the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving,  
8 removal, demolition, conversion, occupancy, equipment, use, height,  
9 area, and maintenance of all buildings and/or structures in the  
10 City of Las Vegas; providing for the issuance of permits, and  
collection of fees therefor; providing penalties for the violation  
thereof; declaring and establishing Fire Zones, repealing Ordinances  
Nos. 144-27-59-61 and 72 of the City of Las Vegas and all other  
Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," shall be  
and the same is hereby amended, revised and re-enacted so that the  
same shall read as follows:

11 "Section 3. All of the area included in the incorporated  
12 limits of the City of Las Vegas shall be within Fire Zone  
13 #3 except those portions which are included in Fire Zone #1  
14 and #2. Fire Zone #1 shall lie within the following described  
15 boundaries, beginning at the intersection of South Main Street  
16 and Carson Avenue, as shown on the Plat of Clark's Las Vegas  
17 Townsite; thence easterly along Carson Avenue to 7th Street;  
18 thence northerly along 7th Street to a point 150 feet North,  
19 measured at right angles, of the North right-of-way line of  
20 Fremont Ave; thence westerly along a line parallel to and  
21 150 feet North of the north right-of-way line of Fremont Avenue  
22 to 3rd Street; thence northerly on 3rd Street to Ogden Avenue;  
23 thence westerly along Ogden Avenue to Main Street; thence  
24 southerly along Main Street to the point of beginning. Fire  
25 Zone #2 shall lie within the following described areas; along  
26 Main Street to a depth of 150 feet each side of the right-of-  
27 way line from the North City limits to its intersection with  
28 South 5th Street; and along 5th Street to a depth of 150  
29 feet each side of the right-or-way line from the South City  
limits to the South 16th line of Section 27; and along East  
Fremont Avenue to a depth of 150 feet each side of the right-  
of-way line from the East City Limits to the alley between  
7th and 8th Streets; and from the alley between 7th and 8th  
Streets to the alley between 5th and 6th Streets, between  
Ogden Avenue and a line 200 feet South and parallel to the  
South right-of-way line of Carson Avenue; and from the alley  
between 4th and 5th Streets to the alley between Main and  
First Streets, between Stewart and Clark Avenues, excepting  
therefrom that portion contained in Fire Zone #1; and between  
Wilson Avenue and Bonanza Road, from Main Street westerly to  
"H" Street; and all of blocks 24 and 25 in the Huntridge  
Addition, and Lot 6, Block 6; Lot 7, Block 5; Lot 8, Block  
11; Lot 6, Block 10; all in the Valley View Addition of the  
City of Las Vegas; also Lot 6, Block 22; Lot 7, Block 21;  
Lots 1 to 6 inclusive in Blocks 11 and 6; Lots 7 to 12 inclusive  
in Blocks 12 & 5; all in the H.F.M. & M. Addition to the City  
of Las Vegas"

30 Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict  
31 herewith are hereby repealed. But it is specifically provided that  
32 that neither the amendment hereby made to said Ordinance nor any  
repeal hereby provided shall effect in any way any prosecution for  
the violation of said Ordinance pending at the time of the going  
into effect of this Ordinance.

1 Section 3. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after  
2 its passage, adoption and publication for two successive issues in  
3 the Las Vegas Age a weekly newspaper  
4 printed and published in the City of Las Vegas.

5 Section 4. The City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas is hereby  
6 authorized and directed to have this City Ordinance published in  
7 the Las Vegas Age a weekly newspaper  
8 printed and published in the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada,  
9 for a period of two weeks, that is to say, once each week for a  
10 period of two weeks.

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ORDINANCE NO. 284.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE, AND RE-ENACT SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 166 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AS AMENDED, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 166 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled: "An Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, demolition, conversion; occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, and maintenance of all buildings and/or structures in the City of Las Vegas; providing for the issuance of permits, and collection of fees therefor; providing penalties for the violation thereof; declaring and establishing Fire Zones, repealing Ordinances Nos. 144-27-59-61 and 72 of the City of Las Vegas and all other Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith," shall be and the same is hereby amended, revised and re-enacted so that the same shall read as follows:

"Section 3. All of the area included in the incorporated limits of the City of Las Vegas shall be within Fire Zone No. 3 except those portions which are included in Fire Zone No. 1 and No. 2: Fire Zone No. 1 shall lie within the following described boundaries, beginning at the intersection of South Main Street and Carson Avenue, as shown on the Plat of Clark's Las Vegas Townsite; thence easterly along Carson Avenue to 7th Street thence northerly along 7th Street to a point 150 feet North, measured at right angles, of the North right-of-way line of Fremont Ave.; thence westerly along a line parallel to and 150 feet North of the north right-of-way line of Fremont Avenue to 3rd Street; thence northerly on 3rd Street to Ogden Avenue; thence westerly along Ogden Avenue to Main Street; thence southerly along Main Street to the point of beginning. Fire Zone No. 2 shall lie within the following described areas: Along Main Street to a depth of 150 feet each side of the right-of-way line from the North City limits to its intersection with South 5th Street; and along 5th Street to a depth of 150 feet each side of the right-of-way line from the South City limits to the South 16th line of Section 27; and along East Fremont Avenue to a depth of 150 feet each side of the right-of-way line from the East City Limits to the alley between 7th and 8th Streets; and from the alley between 5th and 6th Streets, between Ogden Avenue and a line 200 feet South and parallel to the South right-of-way line of Carson Avenue; and from the alley between 4th and 5th Streets to the alley between Main and First Streets, between Stewart and Clark Avenues, excepting therefrom that portion contained in Fire Zone No. 1 and between Wilson Avenue and Bonanza Road, from Main Street westerly to "H" Street; and all of blocks 24 and 25 in the Huntridge Addition, and Lot 6, Block 6; Lot 7, Block 5; Lot 7, Block 11; Lot 6, Block 10; all in the Valley View Addition of the City of Las Vegas; also Lot 6, Block 22; Lot 7, Block 21; Lots 1 to 6 inclusive in Blocks 11 and 6; Lots 7 to 12 inclusive in Blocks 12 and 5; all in the H. F. M. & M. Addition to the City of Las Vegas."

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. But it is specifically provided that that neither the amendment hereby made to said Ordinance nor any repeal hereby provided shall effect in any way any prosecution for the violation of said Ordinance pending at the time of the going into effect of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, adoption and publication for two successive issues in the Las Vegas Age a weekly newspaper printed and published in the City of Las Vegas.

Section 4. The City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas is hereby authorized and directed to have this City Ordinance published in the Las Vegas Age, a weekly newspaper printed and pub-

lished in the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, for a period of two weeks, that is to say, once each week for a period of two weeks.
