

1 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 468 ENTITLED: "AN
2 EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, COUNTY OF CLARK,
3 STATE OF NEVADA, CREATING AND ESTABLISHING CIVIL SERVICE RULES
4 AND REGULATIONS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF SAID CITY, DEFINING TERMS;
5 PROVIDING FOR EXAMINATION; ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY LISTS; PRO-
6 VIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS; PROMOTIONS; DISCIPLINARY ACTION; REPORTS
7 AND RECORDS; CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLANS; AND ALL MATTERS RELAT-
8 ING THERETO; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 391 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES
9 OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH," BY CHANGING THE
10 AGE REQUIREMENTS AND PROVIDING FOR EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS OF
11 APPLICANTS FOR THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY; AND
12 REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT
13 HEREWITH.

14 THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DO
15 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

16 SECTION 1. SECTION IV, PARAGRAPH G, OF THE CIVIL SERVICE
17 RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS IS HEREBY AMENDED
18 TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

19 AGE AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS. ALL APPLICANTS FOR
20 POSITIONS IN THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF
21 LAS VEGAS SHALL MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS.

22 (1) APPLICANT SHALL HAVE REACHED HIS 21ST BIRTHDAY BUT
23 SHALL NOT HAVE REACHED HIS 36TH BIRTHDAY; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT
24 CONSIDERATION SHALL BE GRANTED FOR PREVIOUS SERVICE RENDERED IN
25 THE TYPE OF WORK APPLIED FOR, IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: FOR EACH
26 YEAR OF PREVIOUS SERVICE THE APPLICANT SHALL RECEIVE ONE YEAR
27 CREDIT ON THE AGE REQUIREMENT, UP TO BUT NOT EXCEEDING FOUR YEARS
28 MAXIMUM CREDIT.

29 (2) APPLICANT SHALL HAVE RECEIVED A HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION
30 AS EVIDENCED BY A DIPLOMA OR OTHER PROOF OF SATISFACTORY COMPLE-
31 TION.

32 SECTION 2. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN
CONFLICT HEREWITH, ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

SECTION 3. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND
EFFECT UPON ITS PUBLICATION, AS IN THE NEXT SECTION PROVIDED,
AND FINAL PASSAGE.

SECTION 4. THE CITY CLERK AND CLERK OF THE BOARD OF COMMISS-
SIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS SHALL CAUSE THIS ORDINANCE TO BE
PUBLISHED ONCE A WEEK FOR TWO SUCCESSIVE WEEKS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOW-
ING ITS FIRST READING AND ADOPTION IN THE LAS VEGAS Review Journal
A DAILY NEWSPAPER PUBLISHED IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS.

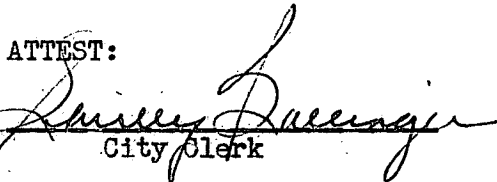

hereby amended to read as follows:

AGE AND EDUCATIONAL RE-
QUIREMENTS. All applicants for po-
sitions in the Police and Fire Depart-
ments of the City of Las Vegas shall
meet the following requirements:

(1) Applicant shall have reached
his 21st birthday but shall not have
reached his 36th birthday; provided,
however, that consideration shall be
granted for previous service rendered
in the type of work applied for, in the
following manner: for each year of
previous service the applicant shall
receive one year credit on the age
requirement, up to but not exceeding
four years maximum credit.

(2) Applicant shall have received a
high school education as evidenced by
a diploma or other proof of satis-
factory completion.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts
of ordinances in conflict herewith,
are hereby repealed.
