ORDINANCE NO. 472

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 29, ALSO REFERRED TO AS SECTION I, CHAPTER 20 OF THE LAS VEGAS CITY CODE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT MINORS FROM FREQUENTING SALOONS AND DISREPUTABLE PLACES" BY PROVIDING THAT A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS SHALL NOT CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PREMISES; BY PROVIDING IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS TO REPRESENT THAT HE IS OVER 21 YEARS OF AGE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING OR OBTAINING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; BY PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN A PUBLIC PLACE BY A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS EXCEPT IN CERTAIN INSTANCES; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. Section I of Ordinance No. 29, also known as Section I, Chapter 20, The Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1929, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to frequent or loiter around any saloon, gambling house, barroom, billiard room, cigar store, or house of ill-fame.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to purchase any alcoholic beverage, or to consume any alcoholic beverage in any on-sale premises.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to present or offer to any licensee authorized to sell alcoholic beverages in the City of Las Vegas, or to his agent or employee, any written evidence of age which is false, fraudulent, or not actually his own, for the purpose of ordering, purchasing, attempting to purchase, or otherwise procuring or attempting to procure, the serving of any alcoholic beverage.

(d) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to have any alcoholic beverage in his possession on any sidewalk, street, highway, or in any other public place, provided, however, this subdivision shall not apply to possession by a person under the age of 21 years making a delivery of such alcoholic beverage in pursuance of his employment, providing the seal is not broken.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its publication as in the next section provided, and final passage.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk and the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this Ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption, in the Las Vegas _____, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.
