

ORDINANCE NO. 487

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 468 ENTITLED: "AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, CREATING AND ESTABLISHING CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF SAID CITY, DEFINING TERMS; PROVIDING FOR EXAMINATION; ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY LISTS; PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS; PROMOTIONS; DISCIPLINARY ACTION; REPORTS AND RECORDS; CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLANS; AND ALL MATTERS RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 391 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH." BY CHANGING THE PHYSICAL QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS FOR POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section IV, Paragraph I, Subparagraph 8 of the Civil Service Rules and Regulations of the City of Las Vegas is hereby amended to read as follows:

Male applicants shall possess a minimum height of 5 feet 9 inches with a minimum weight of 160 pounds.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its publication, as in the next section provided, and final passage.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption in the Las Vegas Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.
