ORDINANCE NO. 6338

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY, TO PARTICULARLY DESCRIBE THE LAND TO BE ANNEXED, TO MAKE ITS INHABITANTS SUBJECT TO THE LAWS, OBLIGATIONS AND BENEFITS OF THE CITY, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS. (ANX-54293)

Sponsored by: Councilman Steven D. Ross Summary: Annexes property described generally as located on the south side of Centennial Parkway, east and west of Conquistador Street.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The corporate limits of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, are hereby extended to annex, include, and make a part of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, the following described real property:

Those portions of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 30, Township 19 South, Range 60 East, MDM, Clark County, Nevada, described as follows:

PARCEL 1
Government Lot 5 in said Section 30.

2 The West Half (W 1/2) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the Northeast
Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 30.

7 SECTION 2: The City Council hereby determines that the described territory
8 meets the requirements provided by law for annexation to the City for the following reasons:

9 A. The area to be annexed was contiguous to the City's boundaries at the time
10 the annexation proceedings were instituted;

11 B. More than one-eighth (1/8) of the aggregate external boundaries of the
12 area are contiguous to the City;

13 C. The territory proposed to be annexed is not included within the boundaries
14 of another incorporated city or within the boundaries of any unincorporated town as those
15 boundaries existed as of July 1, 1983;

16 D. The City is eligible to annex the described territory because the
17 landowners have signed a petition constituting one hundred percent (100%) of the owners of record
18 of individual lots or parcels of land within the annexation area.

19 SECTION 3: The City will provide police protection through the Las Vegas
20 Metropolitan Police Department, fire protection, street maintenance, and library services
21 immediately upon annexation. Garbage collection by the company franchised by the City will also
22 be provided immediately. The City sanitary sewer system will serve the proposed annexation area.
23 Any connection to or extension of this sewer line to serve the annexation area shall be at the
24 expense of the landowners. Other services, such as participation in the City's recreational
25 programs, special education classes and programs, public works planning, building inspections, and

1 other City services will also be available immediately. Utilities such as gas, electricity, telephone,
2 and water are provided by private utility companies and other services to the area will not be
3 affected by annexation. Street paving, curbs and gutters, sidewalks and street lights which are not
4 in place at the time of annexation will be installed in the presently developed areas upon the request
5 of the property owners and at their expense by means of special assessment districts. Such
6 improvements will be extended into the undeveloped areas as development takes place and the
7 need therefor arises, and will be located according to the needs of the area at that time. Such
8 installations will also be made at the expense of the property owners, either by means of special
9 assessment districts or as prerequisites to the approval of subdivision plats, building permits or
10 other land use or development applications.

11 SECTION 4: The annexation of the described territory shall become effective
12 on the 15th day of August, 2014, and on that date the City will have the funds appropriated in
13 sufficient amount to finance the extension into the described territory of police protection, fire
14 protection, street maintenance, street sweeping, and street lighting maintenance.

15 SECTION 5: The described territory, together with the inhabitants and property
16 thereof, shall, from and after the 15th day of August, 2014, be subject to all debts, laws, ordinances
17 and regulations in force in the City and shall be entitled to the same privileges and benefits as other
18 parts of the City, and shall be subject to municipal taxes levied by the City.

19 SECTION 6: The City Engineer is hereby instructed to cause to be prepared an
20 accurate map or plat of the described territory and to record the map or plat, together with a
21 certified copy of this ordinance, in the office of the County Recorder of Clark County, Nevada,
22 which recording shall be done prior to the 15th day of August, 2014.

23 SECTION 7: The described territory, which previously has been zoned R-D
24 (County of Clark classification), is hereby classified as R-1 (City of Las Vegas classification),
25 which is deemed to be the City equivalent of the County classification.

1 SECTION 8: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause
2 or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
3 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
4 validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City
5 Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section,
6 subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that
7 any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
8 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.


9 SECTION 9: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections,
10 phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las
11 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
