3 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO NON-MOVING (PARKING) VIOLATIONS; AMENDING THE
4 SCHEDULE OF FINES AND PENALTIES IN LVMC 11.10.140 TO INCREASE FINE AND PENALTY
5 AMOUNTS IN VARIOUS CATEGORIES; AMENDING VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF LVMC TITLES
6 10 AND 11 TO PROVIDE CLARIFYING AND PARALLEL AMENDMENTS, AND TO UPDATE
7 TERMINOLOGY AND PROCEDURES RELATING TO THE CITY'S USE OF VEHICLE
8 IMMOBILIZATION DEVICES; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Amends the schedule of fines and penalties in LVMC 11.10.140 pertaining to non-moving (parking) violations to increase fine and penalty amounts in various categories, and amends various provisions of LVMC Titles 10 and 11 to provide clarifying and parallel amendments, including an update to terminology and procedures relating to the City's use of vehicle immobilization devices.

12 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
13 FOLLOWS:

14 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 2, Section 50, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
15 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 **11.02.050:** ["City-owned parking lot" or "City-owned lot"] "City parking facility" includes a parking
17 lot, [or parking structure] parking garage, or other parking structure or facility which the City owns, operates
18 or maintains, or in which the City enforces the provisions of this Title.

19 SECTION 2: Title 11, Chapter 2, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
20 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 85, reading as
21 follows:

22 **11.02.085:** "Immobilization device," "immobilizing device" or "immobilizer" means a device that
23 immobilizes a parked motor vehicle or otherwise renders it incapable of being driven away from a particular
24 location. The term includes without limitation any device or mechanism that attaches to:

- 25 (1) The tire, wheel or any other exterior part of a vehicle so as to make the vehicle inoperable;
26 or

1 (2) The front windshield of a vehicle so as to obstruct the driver's view through the windshield.

2 SECTION 3: Title 11, Chapter 10, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
3 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 **11.10.010:** (A) It is a civil infraction, for which both the registered owner and the operator of a
5 vehicle are liable, for such vehicle to be parked or found in violation of any of the parking laws which are set
6 forth in this Title.

7 (B) Nothing in this Title shall prohibit the parking of a vehicle, consistent with public
8 safety, by a physically handicapped person, a disabled veteran or a person transporting a physically
9 handicapped person or disabled veteran in compliance with NRS 484B.463.

10 (C) For purposes of the provisions of this Title that pertain to the parking, stopping,
11 standing or loading of vehicles, unless otherwise indicated:

12 (1) "Operator" means and includes every individual who operates a vehicle as
13 the owner thereof, or as the agent, employee or permittee of the owner, or is in actual physical control of a
14 vehicle.

15 (2) "Park" or "parking" means the standing, stopping or halting of a vehicle,
16 whether occupied or not, upon a street, including temporarily for the purpose of, and while engaged in,
17 receiving or discharging passengers or loading or unloading freight, cargo, merchandise or other goods, but
18 not including in obedience to traffic regulations, signs or signals or an involuntary stopping of the vehicle by
19 reason of causes beyond the control of the operator of the vehicle.

20 (3) "Parking meter" means and includes any mechanical device or meter not
21 inconsistent with this Title placed or erected for the regulation of parking by authority of this Title.

22 (4) "Parking meter space" means any space within a parking meter zone that is
23 assigned to or governed by a parking meter, duly designated for the parking of a single vehicle, and marked
24 as such by painted lines or other durable markings on the curb, street surface, or other location for the space.

25 (5) "Parking meter zone" includes any street or City parking facility upon or in
26 which parking meters are installed and in operation. [, as well as any City-owned parking lot.]

1 (6) "Registered owner" means a person whose name appears in the records of
2 the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles as the person to whom a vehicle is registered.

3 (7) "Street" means any public street, avenue, road, alley, highway, lane, path or
4 other public place located in the City and established for the conveyance of vehicular traffic.

5 (8) "Vehicle" means any device in, upon or by which any person or property is
6 or may be transported upon a highway, except a device which is operated upon rails or tracks.

7 (D) For purposes of this Chapter:

8 (1) "Level 1 appeal" means the initial process for appealing a Notice of
9 Infraction under this Chapter, as described in LVMC 11.10.080.

10 (2) "Level 2 appeal" means the process for further appealing the decision made
11 in a Level 1 appeal, as described in LVMC 11.10.100.

12 (3) "Parking Services Division" means the Parking Services Division of the
13 Department of Economic and Urban Development.

14 (4) "Schedule of fines and penalties" means the schedule adopted pursuant to
15 LVMC 11.10.140.

16 SECTION 4: Title 11, Chapter 10, Section 140, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
17 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 **11.10.140:** (A) There is hereby adopted a schedule of fines and penalties for infractions of the
19 parking laws and regulations which are set forth in this Title, as well as infractions processed under this
20 Chapter as civil violations pursuant to LVMC 10.78.020 or 13.04.070(A). The schedule is set forth as
21 Subsection (D) of this Section. In the case of any violation that is not specifically identified in the schedule,
22 the fine shall be [twenty] twenty-five dollars, with the penalties to be determined as in the case of a violation
23 specifically listed with a fine amount of [twenty] twenty-five dollars.

24 (B) The owner and/or operator shall be liable for an additional collection fee where the
25 collection of the fines, [and] parking permit fees, parking facility usage fees, and penalties provided for
26 [herein] in this Title is referred for collection to a private collection agency. The amount of such fee may not

1 exceed twenty-five percent of the outstanding indebtedness or two hundred fifty dollars, whichever is less.
 2 The amount of any such collection fee shall accrue and become due and payable at the time the indebtedness
 3 is referred for collection to the collection agency, and that amount may be added by the collection agency or
 4 the Parking Services Division to the amount sought to be collected. Any judgment or amended judgment
 5 entered under this Chapter may include the amount of the collection fee authorized by this Subsection (B).

6 (C) When a notice of nonpayment of a civil fine imposed under this Chapter has been
 7 filed with the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles pursuant to NRS 484B.527, the City is authorized to
 8 charge the party liable an administrative fee of fifteen dollars to cover the costs of the filing, handling and
 9 release of the notice of nonpayment. The administrative fee shall be paid at the time the fine is collected and
 10 the release authorized.

11 (D) Schedule of Fines and Penalties.

17 SECTION 5: Title 11, Chapter 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas,
18 Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 245, reading
19 as follows:

20 **11.10.245:** In connection with the use of an immobilization device pursuant to this Chapter, the City is
21 authorized to employ, either by itself or by means of contract, equipment and technologies that allow the
22 operator or owner of a vehicle to unlock or otherwise release the immobilization device by the electronic
23 payment of delinquent fines and immobilization fees. In connection with the use of such equipment and
24 technologies, and in addition to and independent of applicable immobilizer fees under this Title, the City may
25 require the operator or owner of a vehicle to:

26 (A) Acknowledge responsibility to return an immobilization device to a designated

1 location within a specified time period; and

2 (B) Authorize a hold to be placed on a debit or credit card account in the amount of
3 seventy-five dollars, to be either 1) released when the device is properly returned, or 2) kept by the City or
4 its vendor if the device is not properly returned within the specified time period.

5 SECTION 6: Title 11, Chapter 10, Section 290, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
6 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 **11.10.290:** (A) The Parking Services Division is authorized to enter into agreements with the
8 owners or lessees of parking lots or parking structures by which the Division will provide parking
9 enforcement services related thereto. The Division shall enforce the parking prohibitions, rules, regulations
10 and limitations that have been agreed upon and established by means of any such agreements. The
11 prohibitions, rules, regulations and limitations to be enforced pursuant to any such agreement may include:

12 (1) The parking-related provisions of this Title as if the parking lot or structure
13 were a [City-owned lot] City parking facility under this Title;

14 (2) The parking prohibitions, rules and regulations that the property owner or
15 lessee has established for the lot or structure; or

16 (3) Any combination thereof.

17 (B) Unless otherwise specified in an agreement referred to in Subsection (A), the parking
18 prohibitions, rules, regulations and limitations established by the agreement shall be deemed to be the City's
19 parking prohibitions, rules, regulations and limitations for purposes of the enforcement provisions, fines and
20 other remedies of this Title. In the case of a parking prohibition, rule, regulation or limitation established by
21 an agreement referred to in Subsection (A) that does not correspond directly to a prohibition, rule, regulation
22 or limitation described in this Title, the Division, for enforcement purposes, is authorized to treat the agreed-
23 upon prohibition, rule, regulation or limitation as if it were the prohibition, rule, regulation or limitation of
24 this Title that most closely corresponds.

25 (C) In order to enforce any parking prohibition, rule, regulation or limitation referred to
26 in Subsection (A), notice of the applicable prohibition, rule, regulation or limitation must be provided to those

1 who will be parking vehicles in the lot or structure, whether by means of signage or otherwise.

2 SECTION 7: Title 11, Chapter 24, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
3 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 **11.24.010:** (A) It is unlawful to do any of the following upon any highway, street or other public
5 thoroughfare within the City:

6 (1) Abandon a vehicle;

7 (2) Park a vehicle:

8 (a) Concerning which there is no valid current registration from the
9 Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles or another state or nation; or

10 (b) Which does not display thereon a valid current license plate[,]
11 bearing a current and valid registration sticker (if required), temporary placard, or moving permit issued for
12 that vehicle by the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles or by another state or nation;

13 (3) Allow a vehicle to remain positioned:

14 (a) On the same highway, street or other public right-of-way adjacent
15 to the same parcel or property line for more than seventy-two consecutive hours;

16 (b) On the same highway, street or other public right-of-way adjacent
17 to the same parcel or property line for more than seventy-two hours of any consecutive ninety-six-hour
18 period;

19 (c) On adjoining highways, streets or other public rights-of-way
20 adjacent to the same parcel or property line for more than seventy-two hours of any consecutive ninety-six-
21 hour period;

22 (4) Park a vehicle and cause it to be suspended on jacks or any other lifting
23 device, except as and to the extent reasonably necessary to change a tire or effect an immediate repair; or

24 (5) Park a vehicle and engage in mechanical repairs thereon, except as and to
25 the extent reasonably necessary to effect an immediate emergency repair.

26 (B) It is unlawful to do any of the following upon or within any [City-owned parking lot

1 or parking garage] City parking facility within the City:

2 (1) Abandon a vehicle;

3 (2) Park a vehicle:

4 (a) Concerning which there is no valid current registration from the
5 Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles or another state or nation; or

6 (b) Which does not display thereon a valid current license plate[,]
7 bearing a current and valid registration sticker (if required), temporary placard, or moving permit issued for
8 that vehicle by the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles or by another state or nation;

9 (3) Park a vehicle and cause it to be suspended on jacks or any other lifting
10 device, except as and to the extent reasonably necessary to change a tire or effect an immediate repair; or

11 (4) Park a vehicle and engage in mechanical repairs thereon, except as and to
12 the extent reasonably necessary to effect an immediate emergency repair.

13 SECTION 8: Title 11, Chapter 44, Section 20, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
14 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 **11.44.020:** Upon those streets or highways or parts of streets or highways described in Schedule 18-
16 I, a copy of which is to be maintained for public inspection in the offices of the City Clerk and the City
17 Traffic Engineer, which may be amended from time to time by written finding of the City Traffic Engineer,
18 no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle for any purpose or period of time other than for the expeditious
19 loading or unloading of passengers in any place marked as a passenger curb-loading zone during hours
20 when the regulations applicable to such curb loading zone are effective, [, and then only for a period not
21 to exceed three minutes.] The time period limitations under this Section are as follows:

22 (A) Not to exceed three minutes, at locations designated as limited to three minutes
23 and posted with signage accordingly.

24 (B) No specific time period but limited to expeditious loading and unloading, at
25 locations designated as an "immediate loading and unloading" zone and posted with signage accordingly.

26 SECTION 9: Title 11, Chapter 52, Section 310, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las

1 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 **11.52.310:** The City Manager is authorized to limit parking [on City-owned or City-leased parking lots]
3 within City parking facilities to certain specified persons, for designated purposes, and for certain specific
4 lengths of time, and to erect signs giving notice of such limitations. In [a non-metered lot or garage, such]
5 any such facility, those limitations may include, among other things, the requirement to pay a fee for parking
6 that is collected upon entrance or exit.

7 SECTION 10: Title 11, Chapter 52, Section 315, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
8 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 **11.52.315:** The City Manager or [his] designee is authorized to cause individual parking spaces within
10 [City-owned parking lots or parking garages] City parking facilities to be marked, either by means of painted
11 lines or other durable markings. Where such parking spaces have been so marked, it is unlawful to park any
12 vehicle:

13 (A) In such a way that the vehicle is not entirely within the limits of a single space so
14 designated; or

15 (B) In an area not marked as a parking space.

16 SECTION 11: Title 11, Chapter 52, Section 320, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
17 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 **11.52.320:** When signs are erected giving notice thereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a
19 vehicle [on City-owned or City-leased parking lots] within a City parking facility in violation of such
20 limitations, [, including the failure to pay a required parking fee in accordance with LVMC 11.52.310.]

21 Violations of this Section include:

22 (A) Parking a vehicle at a location within the City parking facility or in a manner that is
23 contrary to or prohibited by the posted limitations; and

24 (B) The failure to pay a required parking fee in accordance with LVMC 11.52.310.

25 SECTION 12: Title 11, Chapter 52, Section 330, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
26 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1 **11.52.330:** (A) The City Council finds that the parking of a vehicle in violation of LVMC 11.52.320
2 is a public nuisance per se and a disruption of the effective use of [City-owned and City-leased parking lots]
3 City parking facilities by those persons authorized to use them. The City Manager or his duly authorized
4 representative shall have the authority to immobilize any vehicle or have any vehicle removed by towing and
5 impounding from a [City-owned or City-leased parking lot] City parking facility if such vehicle is found to
6 be in violation of LVMC 11.52.320. All expenses incurred in the immobilization or towing and impounding
7 of such vehicle found to be in violation shall be the responsibility of and charged to the registered owner of
8 said vehicle and shall be paid prior to removal of the immobilizer or prior to release of the vehicle from
9 impoundment. The fee for releasing any car immobilized or impounded under this Section is fifty dollars.

10 (B) Citations issued for the violation of LVMC 11.52.320 shall be disposed of under
11 normal procedures and need not be paid as a condition for the release of the vehicle from custody.

12 SECTION 13: Title 11, Chapter 52, Section 340, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
13 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 **11.52.340:** The City Council may designate parking spaces upon City streets or in [City-owned lots]
15 City parking facilities for the parking of City vehicles. It is unlawful to park a vehicle other than a City
16 vehicle in any such space that has been duly posted or marked.

17 SECTION 14: Title 11, Chapter 542, Section 100, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
18 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 **11.54.100:** Parking or standing a vehicle in a parking meter space on the streets and parts of streets that
20 are designated in Schedule 3-I, as the same is established pursuant to LVMC 11.54.020, or in any [City-
21 owned parking lot,] City parking facility is permissible in accordance with the rates and time limits which
22 have been:

23 (A) Established by the Parking Services Division of the Department of Economic and
24 Urban Development, and approved by the City Manager; and

25 (B) Indicated upon the parking meter or by means of a duly-posted sign.

26 SECTION 15: Title 11, Chapter 54, Section 110, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las

1 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 **11.54.110:** Notwithstanding any other provision of this Title pertaining to metered parking, the City
3 Manager or a designee may establish and implement a policy under which specific parking spaces or parking
4 space areas within a [City-owned parking lot] City parking facility may be used without the need to activate
5 the corresponding parking meter in the manner otherwise required.

6 SECTION 16: Title 10, Chapter 78, Section 50, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
7 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 **10.78.050:** (A) In the case of a criminal prosecution for a violation of Section 10.78.020, any person
9 who is convicted of a violation thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than two hundred fifty dollars
10 nor more than one thousand dollars or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any
11 combination of such fine or punishment.

12 (B) In the case of a civil proceeding for a violation of Section 10.78.020, any person in
13 violation thereof shall be deemed to have committed a civil infraction, for which the registered owner and
14 the operator of the vehicle shall be liable. Such civil infraction shall be in the amount of one hundred dollars
15 and shall be subject to the rules and procedures contained in LVMC Chapter 11.10. Members of the Las
16 Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and the Department of Public Safety are authorized to immobilize a
17 motor vehicle displayed in violation of this Chapter through the use of [a motor vehicle immobilizer,
18 sometimes referred to as a "French boot" or "Denver boot,"] an immobilization device, as defined in LVMC

23 SECTION 17: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
24 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by
25 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
26 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby

1 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
2 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
3 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

4 SECTION 18: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to
5 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required
6 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of
7 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon
8 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of
9 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation
10 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

11 SECTION 19: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
12 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983
13 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



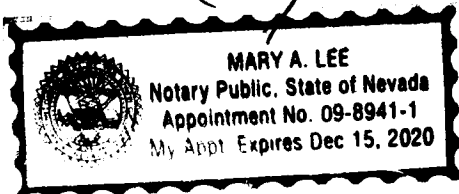
