ORDINANCE NO. 6716

AN ORDINANCE TO GENERALLY PROHIBIT WITHIN THE PEDESTRIAN MALL AND SURROUNDING AREAS THE USE OR POSSESSION OF CERTAIN TYPES OF WEAPONS AND IMPLEMENTS, AS WELL AS TOY AND REPLICA FIREARMS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Sponsored by: Councilwoman Olivia Diaz

Summary: Generally prohibits within the Pedestrian Mall and surrounding areas the use or possession of certain types of weapons and implements, as well as toy and replica firearms.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 10 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new chapter, designated as Chapter 73 and consisting of Sections 10 and 20 thereof, reading as follows:

10.73.010: For purposes of this Chapter:

(A) "Designated area" includes:

(1) The Pedestrian Mall described in LVMC Chapter 11.68; and

(2) Any public sidewalk within the area bounded by the west right-of-way line of Main Street on the west, the north right-of-way line of Ogden Avenue on the north, the east right-of-way line of 7th Street on the east, and the south right-of-way line of Carson Avenue on the south.

(B) "Public right-of-way" means the full width (or any portion) of any dedicated street, alley or highway, whether or not improved.

(C) "Public sidewalk" means that portion of any public right-of-way that has been designed and improved for pedestrian traffic.

10.73.020: Except as otherwise expressly allowed by State law, a provision of this Code, or a written permit or other written authorization issued pursuant to this Code, it is unlawful for any person to use or display within any designated area any of the following:

- 1 (A) A sword;
- 2 (B) A knife or other bladed edge with a blade longer than three inches;
- 3 (C) A bow and arrow or arrows, including a crossbow;
- 4 (D) A device emitting flames of three inches or higher; or
- 5 (E) Any toy firearm, imitation firearm, or replica firearm which substantially duplicates
- 6 and can reasonably be perceived to be an actual operable firearm, as "firearm" is defined in NRS 202.253.

7 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase

8 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by

9 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the

10 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby

11 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase

12 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,

13 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

14 SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to

15 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required

16 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of

17 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon

18 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of

19 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation

20 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.
