10 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
11 FOLLOWS:

12 SECTION 1: In February 2019, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 6675, which
13 authorized, on a temporary basis, the waiver of certain business license-related fees and charges for qualifying
14 new businesses within the Las Vegas Medical District. The intent of that ordinance was to encourage within
15 that District the establishment of new businesses of the types listed. The City Council desires to extend for
16 another two years the effects of that ordinance for new applications. Therefore, the Department of Planning
17 or its successor, in accordance with Ordinance No. 6675 and this Ordinance, may waive the license-related
18 fees and charges listed in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 6675 for qualifying businesses.

19 SECTION 2: In addition to the qualifying new businesses listed in Section 3 of Ordinance
20 No. 6675, the waiver provisions of Ordinance No. 6675 and this Ordinance shall be available to
21 establishments with a tavern-limited alcoholic beverage license.

22 SECTION 3: Except with respect to establishments described in Section 2 of this
23 Ordinance, a waiver referred to in Section 1 of this Ordinance may be granted pursuant to a qualifying waiver
24 application that is filed with the Department between February 23, 2019, and February 23, 2023. A waiver
25 with respect to establishments described in Section 2 of this Ordinance may be granted pursuant to a
26 qualifying waiver application that is filed with the Department between the effective date of this Ordinance

1 and February 23, 2023. Any such waiver shall be conditioned upon activation of the business license within
2 the following time periods after the submittal of a qualifying waiver application:

3 (A) One year, for a business to be located within an existing structure; or

4 (B) Two years, otherwise.

5 SECTION 4: Sections 4 and 5 of Ordinance No. 6675 shall remain in full force and effect
6 with respect to applications under both Ordinance No. 6675 and this Ordinance.

7 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
8 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by
9 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
10 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby
11 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
12 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
13 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

14 SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
15 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983
16 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


