3 ORDINANCE NO. 6740

4 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND LVMC 6.74.050 AND 19.12.070 RELATING TO THE PERMISSIBLE
5 LOCATIONS FOR SECONDHAND DEALERS; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED
MATTERS.

Summary: Amends LVMC 6.74.050 and
7 19.12.070 relating to the permissible locations for
secondhand dealers.

8 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
9 FOLLOWS:

10 SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 74, Section 50, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
11 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 **6.74.050:** A secondhand dealer’s license must not be issued to a location [on Fremont Street or on Las
13 Vegas Boulevard South between Charleston Boulevard and Sahara Avenue.] unless the location conforms to
14 the requirements of LVMC Title 19.

15 SECTION 2: Ordinance No. 6289 and the Unified Development Code adopted as Title 19
16 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, are hereby amended as set forth in
17 Sections 3 to 4, inclusive, of this Ordinance. The amendments are deemed to be amendments to both
18 Ordinance No. 6289 and the Unified Development Code adopted as Title 19.

19 SECTION 3: Title 19, Chapter 12, Section 70, is hereby amended by amending the entry
20 for the use “Secondhand Dealer” so that the Conditional Use Regulations for that use read as follows:

21 **Conditional Use Regulations:**

22 1. No outdoor display or sales of any merchandise shall be permitted, except as allowed pursuant to
23 LVMC 19.16.160 for a Temporary Commercial Permit.

24 2. The use shall comply with the applicable requirements of LVMC Title 6.

25 3. Except as provided in this Regulation 3, [No] no secondhand dealer shall be located on either side of
26 Fremont Street or on Las Vegas Boulevard South between Charleston Boulevard and Sahara Avenue. A

1 secondhand dealer may be located on Fremont Street between Las Vegas Boulevard and 8th Street, but only
2 if the dealer does not engage in the selling or trading of firearms.

3 4. In the C-1 and C-2 Zoning Districts, the use shall be limited to no more than 5,000 square feet in size.

4 SECTION 4: Title 19, Chapter 12, Section 70, is hereby amended by amending the entry
5 for the use "Secondhand Dealer" so that the Minimum Special Use Permit Requirements for that use read as
6 follows:

7 **Minimum Special Use Permit Requirements:**

8 *1. No outdoor display or sales of any merchandise shall be permitted, except as allowed pursuant to
9 LVMC 19.16.160 for a Temporary Commercial Permit.

10 *2. The use shall comply with the applicable requirements of LVMC Title 6.

11 *3. Except as provided in this Requirement 3, [No] no secondhand dealer shall be located on either side of
12 Fremont Street or on Las Vegas Boulevard South between Charleston Boulevard and Sahara Avenue. A
13 secondhand dealer may be located on Fremont Street between Las Vegas Boulevard and 8th Street, but only
14 if the dealer does not engage in the selling or trading of firearms.

15 SECTION 5: For purposes of Section 2.100(3) of the City Charter, Section 19.12.070 is
16 deemed to be a subchapter rather than a section.

17 SECTION 6: The Department of Planning is authorized and directed to incorporate into
18 the Unified Development Code the amendments contained in Sections 3 to 4, inclusive, of this Ordinance.

19 SECTION 7: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
20 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by
21 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
22 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby
23 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
24 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
25 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

26 SECTION 8: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to

1 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required
2 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of
3 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon
4 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of
5 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation
6 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.


7 SECTION 9: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,


