**ORDINANCE NO. 6742**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND LVMC 6.82.060, PERTAINING TO SMOKING LOUNGES, TO UPDATE AN AGE LIMITATION TO BE MORE CONSISTENT WITH FEDERAL LAW REGARDING TOBACCO SALES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Proposed by: Robert Summerfield, Director of Planning

Summary: Amends LVMC 6.82.060, pertaining to smoking lounges, to update an age limitation to be more consistent with Federal law regarding tobacco sales.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 82, Section 60, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**6.82.060:** It is unlawful for any business subject to licensing as a smoking lounge to:

(A) Employ a person under the age of eighteen years (or allow such an employee) to sell or handle tobacco products or tobacco paraphernalia;

(B) Allow a person under the age of [eighteen] twenty-one years to consume tobacco products; or

(C) Allow patron consumption of marijuana, concentrated marijuana or marijuana products.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to

1 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required  
2 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of  
3 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon  
4 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of  
5 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation  
6 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.


7 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
