ORDINANCE NO. 6743

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE, ON A TEMPORARY BASIS, A PARTIAL WAIVER OF THE ORIGINATION CHARGE FOR NEW RESTAURANT SERVICE BAR LICENSES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Sponsored by: Councilwoman Victoria Seaman

Summary: Authorizes, on a temporary basis, a partial waiver of the origination charge for new restaurant service bar licenses.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: In order to encourage new restaurant service bar licenses within the City, the Business Licensing Division of the Department of Planning, in accordance with Section 2 of this Ordinance, may waive up to five-sixths of the amount of the origination charge otherwise imposed by LVMC 6.50.380.

SECTION 2: The partial waiver referred to in Section 1 of this Ordinance may be granted pursuant to a qualifying waiver application that is filed with the Division between the effective date of this Ordinance and December 31, 2020. Any such waiver shall be conditioned upon activation of the business license within the following time periods after the submittal of a qualifying waiver application:

- (A) One year, for a business to be located within an existing structure; or
- (B) Two years, otherwise.

SECTION 3: Notwithstanding any provision of Title 6 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code to the contrary, a business license concerning which a waiver has been granted pursuant to this Ordinance and which has been activated:

- (A) May not be sold or transferred to a third party; and
- (B) May not be transferred to a new location unless the location is within the district to which the license pertains, the location is approved in accordance with the requirements of Title 19, and the license holder remains the same.

SECTION 4: For purposes of Sections 2 and 3 of this Ordinance:

1 (A) "Activation of a business license" means that the license has been issued and the
2 business authorized by the license has opened for business operation.

3 (B) "Qualifying waiver application" means an application for waiver that is:

4 (1) Submitted in connection with a business license application; and

5 (2) Accompanied by a copy of one of the following documents that has been
6 filed with the Department of Planning pursuant to Title 19 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code:

7 (a) An application for a special use permit, if one is required; or

8 (b) A conditional use verification, otherwise.

9 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
10 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by
11 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
12 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby
13 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
14 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
15 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

16 SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
17 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983
18 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
