Summary: Amends the Southern Nevada  
7 Amendments to the 2018 Uniform Mechanical  
8 Code, as adopted by the City, to correct contact  
information regarding certain boilers and water  
heaters.

9 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS  
10 FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION 1: The document entitled "Southern Nevada Amendments to the 2018 Uniform  
12 Mechanical Code," which was adopted by Ordinance No. 6637, is hereby amended as set forth in Section 2  
13 of this Ordinance.

14 SECTION 2: Section 1001.1 of the "Southern Nevada Amendments to the 2018  
15 Mechanical Code" is amended to read as follows, with strikethrough showing deleted material and  
16 underlining showing new material:

17 **1001.1 Applicability.** For boilers and water heaters less than 120 gallon capacity, or a BTU input rating less  
18 than 200,000, or less than 160 pounds per square inch of pressure, see Chapter 5 of the Uniform Plumbing  
19 Code. For all other units, contact the Mechanical Compliance Section of the Nevada ~~Division of Occupational~~  
20 ~~Safety and Health, part of the Office of Business and Industrial Relations, State of Nevada Division of~~  
21 Industrial Relations.

22 (Exceptions (1) through (8) remain unchanged)

23 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase  
24 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by  
25 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the  
26 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby

1 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase  
2 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,  
3 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

4 SECTION 4: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to  
5 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required  
6 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of  
7 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon  
8 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of  
9 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation  
10 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

11 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,  
12 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983  
13 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

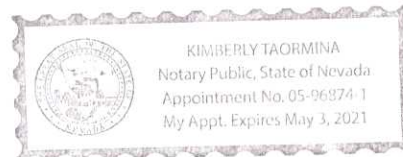
