At a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, held on the 23rd day of August, A.D. 1922, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock p.m. Present Mayor Pro Tem W.H. Dentner with Commissioners Thos. R. Hodgens, W.E. Arnold and R.W. Gorton, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk.

At this time a committee from the Chamber of Commerce, consisting of Dr. R.W. Martin, Leslie B. Saunders, and Ed. J. Clark, together with a number of interested citizens appeared before the Board with the purpose of discussing the possibility of obtaining a reduction in the school tax rate. After listening to a number of speakers, J.H. Harting, Clerk of the School Board made the statement that the matter would be thoroughly gone into at a meeting of the School Board, and a decision made as to whether the rate asked will be lowered.

Upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, and duly carried it was decided to display a map of the city upon the screen at the picture show for the purpose of informing citizens that house numbers can now be procured from the City Clerk. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Gorton and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Upon motion of Commissioner Gorton, seconded by Commissioner Hodgens, and duly carried the Street Commissioner was authorized to sell the remains of the old water wagon truck at the best available price. Voting Commissioner Hodgens, Arnold, Gorton and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, and duly carried the Board adjourned until the next regular meeting to be held on the 6th day of September, A.D. 1922 at the hour of seven o'clock P.M. Voting Commissioners Arnold, Gorton, Hodgens, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Sept. 6, 1922.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 6th day of September, A.D. 1922, at the hour of seven o'clock P.M. Present His Honor the Mayor Pro Tem W.H. Dentner, with members Thos. R. Hodgens, and W.E. Arnold, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk, Commissioner R.W. Gorton being absent.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Reports of officers read, approved and ordered placed on file.

All bills allowed as per claim book on file with the Clerk of this Board excepting the following: the claim of T.S. Rhoads for \$4.78 was rejected on the grounds that more than six months had expired since the contraction of the claim; the claim of Ed. Von Töbel Lumber Co. in the sum of \$1.40 was ordered returned with instructions to have same presented to the P.S. and W.V. Hirsch Co. of Las Angeles, Cal; the claim of Gorton and Hood for \$9.75 was ordered held for further investigation.

A discussion of water service coming on before the Board, it was ordered, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, that the Clerk be and she is hereby directed to notify W.B. Bracken, Agent of the Las Vegas Land and Water Company that if the com-

finds it necessary to shut the water off for any length of time, that it is the desire of the Board of City Commissioners that a by-pass be used in order not to interfere with the fire protection of the City. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and His Honor the Mayor Pro Tem, Aye. Hoos, none.

It was the order of the Board, upon motion of Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Arnold that the chemical tanks be removed from the old fire truck, placed on wheels and stationed in Old Town, (Original Town Site), and that Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgens, be and he is hereby authorized to provide shelter for said chemical tank and to organize a volunteer fire company in said Original Townsite. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Hoos, none.

It was the order of the Board upon motion of Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Hodgens, that the Street Commissioner be and he is hereby authorized to haul gravel and construct a driveway in front of the fire house. Voting Commissioners Arnold, Hodgens, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Hoos, none.

It was the order of the Board upon motion duly made by Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, seconded, by Commissioner Hodgens, that the Street Commissioner be and he is hereby authorized to haul gravel for a sidewalk on Fremont Street between Fifth Street and Eleventh Street; on Seventh Street between Fremont and Ogden Streets and on Eighth Street between Fremont and Carson Streets. Voting Commissioners Arnold, Hodgens, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Hoos, none. It was further ordered that the City Clerk draw a warrant in favor of said agent Frank Brickie, in the said sum of \$1,000.00.

It was the order of the Board, upon motion of Mayor pro Tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Hodgens that the City of Las Vegas accept the sum of One thousand Dollars donated by citizens of the City of Las Vegas for the improvement of the County and City Fair Grounds, and that said One Thousand Dollars be distributed and paid out as ordered before, through its official agent Frank Brickie, said agent to make a regular monthly accounting of his expenditures to this Board. Voting Commissioners Arnold, Hodgens, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Hoos, none.

It was the order of the Board upon motion of Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Hodgens, that the sum of Twenty Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated in payment of expenses incurred by the City of Las Vegas on the 4th day of September, and it was the further order of the Board that the clerk be and she is hereby directed to draw a warrant for said sum of Twenty Dollars in favor of J.E. Piazza. Voting Commissioners Arnold, Hodgens, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Hoos, none.

At this time it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, that the former order of this Board designating the Las Vegas Review as the official newspaper of the City of Las Vegas be and the same is hereby revoked. Voting Commissioner Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Commissioner Hodgens, No. It was carried.

At this time the Clerk presented for action proposed Ordinance No. 95 of the City of Las Vegas which was read for the second time on the 16th day of August, 1922. At this time Mayor Pro Tem Dentner proposed to amend said Ordinance by changing the name of the newspaper in which publication was ordered from the "Las Vegas Review" to the "Las Vegas Age", section 2. This amendment was seconded by Commissioner Arnold. Voting Commissioner Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Commissioner Hodgens, No. It was carried.

Whereupon the Clerk read proposed Ordinance No. 95, as amended, and the same was adopted upon motion of Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Arnold. Voting Commissioners Arnold, Hodgens and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Hoos, none.

Whereupon, it was the order of the Board upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, that the meeting times of the Board be changed to the first and third Wednesdays of each month, at the hour of three o'clock p.m. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Hoos, none.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, it was ordered that the Board adjourn until Wednesday the 20th day of September, 1922, at the hour of three o'clock p.m. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Hoos, none.

September 20, 1922.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, Nevada, held on the 20th day of September, 1922, at the hour of three o'clock p.m. present His Honor the Mayor Pro Tem W. H. Dentner, with Commissioners Messrs. R. Hodgens, W. Arnold and R. V. Gorton, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, and approved as read upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Gorton. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold, Gorton and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

All bills allowed as per claim book on file with the clerk of this Board, excepting the A letter of thanks from the American Legion for the donation made by the City of Las Vegas for the erection of a bronze memorial for the soldiers from Clark County who fell in the World War was read and ordered placed on file.

Dr. W. S. Park appeared before the Board asking for permission to extend the portico of a building which he is about to erect on Second Street between Fremont and Carson, out over the sidewalk as a protection to the windows in the lower floor. Thereupon it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Gorton, seconded by Commissioner Hodgens, that the Police and Fire Commissioner and the City Clerk execute and deliver a formal permit, upon the approval of the same by the Board of Commissioners, granting permission to Dr. Park to build the above mentioned portico, as far as the rights of the City of Las Vegas are concerned. The vote on said motion was as follows; Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Gorton, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

It was the order of the Board upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Gorton, that a man be employed for the sum of \$25.00 per month to keep the fire engines in first class working order, and Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgens, was authorized by the Board to employ such a man and to supervise the duties of said employee. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold, Gorton and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Gorton, it was ordered that the Chamber of Commerce be requested to cooperate with the City and County Agents in working out a satisfactory scheme for handling the advertising on the fence surrounding the City and County Fair Grounds. Voting, Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold, Gorton and Mayor Pro Tem, Dentner, Aye.

The City Clerk was instructed, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Gorton, to notify the health officer Dr. C. E. Buletter that it was the desire of the Board of City Commissioners that said health officer appear at at least one meeting of the Board in each month. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold, Gorton and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Thereupon, there being no further business to come before the Board at this time, it was ordered, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, that the Board Adjourn until the next regular meeting.
