At this time it was ordered, upon motion of Commissioner Arnold, seconded by Commissioner Hodgens, and unanimously carried that the Board adjourn until Thursday, November 2nd, 1922, at the hour of three o'clock p.m. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner. Aye. Noes, none.

At a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, held on the 2nd day of November, A.D. 1922, at the hour of three o'clock p.m. Present Hon. F.H. Dentner, Mayor Pro Tem, with members Thos. R. Hodgens and J.E. Arnold, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk. Commissioner R.J. Gorton, absent.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, and duly carried on the following vote; Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye; Noes, none.

Reports of officers read, approved and ordered placed on file.

All bills allowed as per claim book on file with the clerk of this Board, excepting the following which were laid over for investigation; Gorton and Hood, \$9.95, Furd and French \$8.00, H.J. Goodwin, two claims for \$15.25 and \$2.95 respectively.

It was the order of the Board upon motion of Mayor pro tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Arnold and duly carried that the Clerk write a letter to Sewer and Light Commissioner Gorton requesting his immediate resignation from the position of Sewer and Light Commissioner in the City of Las Vegas. Voting on said motion Commissioners Arnold, Hodgens and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye, Noes, none.

Thereupon it was the order of the Board that the Clerk notify the local newspapers of the expected vacancy in the City Board and request that notice be given to the public inviting applications from citizens willing to fill said expected vacancy.

At this time it was the order of the Board upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold and duly carried that the City Attorney be and he is hereby instructed to draw up an ordinance requiring an attendance of every member of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas at at least one meeting a month. Voting on said motion Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye, Noes, None.

It was suggested by Mayor Pro Tem Dentner that the matter of providing for mill inspection be looked into by the City Attorney.

At this time the Clerk presented the application of J.E. Moran for a gaming license (two tables) at the Hotel Northern, the same having been previously approved by Police and

Fire Commissioner Hodgens as by law provided. Thereupon it was the order of the Board on motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold and duly carried the said J.H.Morgan be granted a gaming license (two tables) at the Hotel Northern, Voting on said motion Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye, Eoes Eone.

At this time Lealie A. Saunders, Executive Secretary of the Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce appeared before the Board and spoke upon various matters of public interest.

At this time upon motion of Mayor Pro Tem Dentner seconded by Commissioner Arnold and duly carried, it was the order of the Board that the Clerk publish a statement in the local papers to the effect that the shop workers are invited to take up their residence in the City of Las Vegas and are guaranteed the same police protection to which all law abiding citizens are entitled. It was the further order of the Board that copies of this statement be sent to the following: Vice President W. E. Calvin; J.P. Carrey, J.E. Morris and General Manager E.A. Williams. WHEREON on said resolution Commissioners Arnold, Hodgens and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye, Eoes Eone.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time it was ordered upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold and duly carried that the Board stand adjourned until Wednesday the 15th day of November A.D. 1922 at 3.00 p.m. Voting on said motion Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye, Eoes, Eone.
