Upon motion of Commissioner Arnold, seconded by Commissioner Blanding, and duly carried, Commissioner Hodgens was appointed Chairman pro tem, in the absence of the Mayor Pro Tem. Voting on said motion, Commissioners Arnold, Blanding and Hodgens, Aye. Noes, none.

At this time it was the motion of Commissioner Arnold, seconded by Commissioner Blanding, and duly carried, that the Board adjourn until Thursday, the 4th day of January, A.D. 1923, at the hour of three o'clock p.m. Voting Commissioners Arnold, Blanding and Hodgens, Aye. Noes, none.

At a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, held on the 4th day of January, A.D. 1923. Present Hon. W.H. Dentner, Mayor Pro Tem, with Commissioners Thos. B. Hodgens, W.B. Arnold and Harry Blanding, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read.

Reports of officers were read, approved and placed on file in the office of the Clerk.

All bills allowed as per claim book on file with the clerk of this Board, excepting the following: The claim of J.T. Ulloa and Son in the sum of \$30.10 was ordered returned for information as to who ordered the articles billed; the claim of Standard Oil Company in the sum of \$8.82 was ordered returned for information as to who ordered the articles purchased.

Thereupon the Clerk presented the application of J.L. McLaurine for a gaming license, (2 games) in the Levy Building of Fremont Street, the same having been theretofore approved by the Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgens, whereupon, it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, that a gaming license be granted to the said J.L. McLaurine. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold, Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Thereupon the Clerk presented the application of J.H. Morgan for a gaming license, (2 games) at the Northern, the same having been theretofore approved by Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgens, whereupon, it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, that a gaming license be granted to the said J.H. Morgan for the Northern. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Thereupon the Clerk presented the application of E.M. Firtle and J.L. Newson for a gaming license, (2 games) at the Overland Bar, the same having been theretofore approved by Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgens, whereupon it was the order of the Board, on motion of Hodgens, seconded by Blanding, that said license be granted. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

Thereupon the Clerk presented the application of J.H. Morgan for a gaming license, (4 games) at the Vegas Bar, the same having been theretofore approved by Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgens, whereupon, it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgens, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, that a gaming license be granted to the said J.H. Morgan, as stated above. Voting Commissioners Hodgens, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

✓ Thereupon the Clerk presented the application of James Germain for a gaming license (2 games) at the Thomas Bldg. on First Street, the same having been theretofore approved by Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgins, whereupon, it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Blanding, that a gaming license be issued to the said James Germain as stated above. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold, and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

✓ Thereupon, the Clerk presented the application of L. Hargraves for a gaming license (2 games) at the Big Four on First Street, the same having been theretofore approved by Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgins, whereupon, it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, that a gaming license be issued to the said L. Hargraves as stated above. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

✓ Thereupon the Clerk presented the application of C.E. Jagger for a gaming license (2 games) at the Arizons Club, the same having been theretofore approved by Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgins, whereupon it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, that a gaming license be issued to the said C.E. Jagger as stated above. Voting, Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold, and Blanding, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye. Noes, none.

✓ Thereupon, Police and Fire Commissioner Hodgins presented the resignation of A.T. McCarter as City Marshall and Fire Chief of the City of Las Vegas, whereupon, it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, that the resignation of A.T. McCarter as City Marshall and Fire Chief of the City of Las Vegas, be and the same is hereby accepted. Voting Com. Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

✓ Thereupon, on motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Arnold, the position of City Marshall and Fire Chief of the City of Las Vegas, was declared vacant. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

On motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Blanding, A.W. Woody was appointed City Marshall at a salary of \$150.00 per month, said appointment to take effect upon his filing a good and sufficient bond in the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, and upon his taking the oath of office. Voting, Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

✓ On motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, A.W. Woody was appointed Fire Chief of the City of Las Vegas, at a salary of Twenty (\$20.00) per month. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye, Noes, none.

Thereupon A.W. Woody presented his bond as City Marshall, in the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars with O.C. Boggs and Will Beckley as sureties thereon, and the same appearing to the Board to be a good and sufficient bond, it was the order of the Board, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Blanding, that said bond of A.W. Woody as City Marshall of the City of Las Vegas be and the same is hereby approved. Voting, Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye. Noes, none.

Thereupon A.W. Woody took the oath of office, as required by law, and entered upon his duties as City Marshall of the City of Las Vegas.

It was ordered, upon motion of Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Blanding that the Street Commissioner get an estimate of the cost of laying a sidewalk on the east side of Fourth street from Fremont to Bridger Street. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold, and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.

A discussion of the number of hoboes and tramps now infesting the city coming on before the Board, it was ordered, upon motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Blanding, that the City Marshall secure the services of Thomas West, or some other competent man as extra policeman to deal exclusively with this problem, and with instructions to keep all hoboes moving through the city. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro

Tom Dentner, Aye Noes, none.

Upon motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Blanding, the City Attorney was directed to draw an ordinance prohibiting aeroplanes from doing stunts over the thickly settled portion of the city, and that said ordinance be handled as an emergency ordinance. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye. Noes, none.

On motion of Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, seconded by Commissioner Hodgins, the Light and Sewer Commissioner was directed to interview the Telephone Company with regard to securing all night service, it appearing to the Board that the growth of the City makes such service urgent. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner Aye. Noes, none.

There being no farther business to come before the Board at this time, it was ordered, on motion of Commissioner Hodgins, seconded by Commissioner Blanding that the Board stand adjourned until the next regular meeting, to be held on Wednesday the seventh day of February, 1923, at three o'clock p.m. Voting Commissioners Hodgins, Arnold and Blanding, and Mayor Pro Tem Dentner, Aye. Noes, none.
