German, Mayor, with Commissioner A.R. Anderson and E.R. Shield, together with the City Clerk and Acting City Attorney, Harley A. Harmon, Esq. Commissioner Elwell absent.

Minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved and approved as read on motion of Commissioner Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Shield. Voting Commissioners Anderson and Shield, and His Honor the Mayor, W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

Reports of officers read and approved and ordered placed on file in the office of the Clerk of this Board.

All claims allowed as per claim book on file with the Clerk of this Board excepting that the claim of L.R. Cookwell/was ordered returned for more definite designation as to the locality in which the work was performed; the claim of Leo A. Crowley in the sum of \$21.00 was ordered laid over for further investigation.

At this time the Clerk presented the Application of J.H. Morgan for a gaming license, (5 games) at the Vegas Bar, the same having been heretofore approved by the Police and Fire Commissioners E.R. Thereupon the Clerk presented the application of H.W. Ball for a gaming license, (2 games) at the Big Four, the same having been theretofore approved by Police and Fire Commissioner Shield, whereupon it was ordered, upon motion of Commissioner Shield, seconded by Commissioner Anderson, and duly carried, that said application be granted and that the Clerk be and she is hereby directed to issue a license as set forth above to the said H.W. Ball. Voting Commissioners Anderson, Shield and His Honor the Mayor, Aye. Noes, none.
