At a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, held on the 22nd day of October, A. D. 1923, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock P. M. Present His Honor the Mayor, W. C. German, with Commissioners A. R. Anderson, C. E. Shield and W. H. Elwell, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk.

At this time the estimate of Division Engineer C. C. Boyer for the paving of the sixteen foot strips of each side of the proposed eighteen foot strip of concrete highway on Fremont Street between Main and third streets, was considered, and it appearing to the Board that the cost of constructing the same would be prohibitive for the City of Las Vegas, it was ordered upon motion of Mayor W. C. German, seconded by Commissioner Anderson, and duly carried, that Mr. Boyer be and he is hereby requested to prepare a similar estimate of the cost of constructing the sixteen foot strips of gravel instead of concrete, and that same be presented at the next regular meeting of the Board to be held on the 6th day of November, 1923, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock P. M. Voting Commissioners Anderson, Shield and Elwell, and His Honor the Mayor W. C. German, Aye. Nays, none.

At this time it was the order of the Board upon motion of Commissioner Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Elwell, that S. T. McWilliams be and he is hereby authorized to establish the sidewalk grade on the east side of Fifth Street between Carson and Bridger Streets at a cost of \$25.00. Voting Commissioner Anderson, Shield and Elwell, and His Honor the Mayor, W. C. German, Aye. Nays, none.

Thereupon, there being no further business to come before the Board at this time, it was ordered, upon motion of Commissioner Shield, seconded by Commissioner Elwell, that the Board adjourn until the next regular meeting, to be held on the 6th day of November, A. D. 1923, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock P. M. Voting Commissioners Anderson, Shield and Elwell, and His Honor the Mayor, W. C. German, Aye. Nays, none.

At a regular adjourned meeting of the board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County Nevada, held on Monday, the 26th day of November, A.D. 1923, at the hour of seven thirty o'clock p. m. Present His Honor the Mayor W. C. German, with Commissioners A. R. Anderson C/ R. Shield and E. H. Elwell, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk.

On motion of Commissioner Anderson, seconded by commissioner Shield, L. R. Hilkie was appointed Paubine Inspector of the City of Las Vegas, at a compensation equal to the amount of fees collected, said appointment to take effect upon the filing and approval of a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$1000.00 and upon his taking the oath of office as required by law.

At this time the Clerk read for the second time proposed Ordinance No. 102 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Subdivision No. 8 of Sec. 2 of Ordinance No. 81 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Section Seven (7) of ordinance no. 48 of the City of Las Vegas, licensing, for the purpose of regulation and revenue, every kind of lawful business herein after specified, transacted or carried on within the corporation limits of the City of Las Vegas, State of Nevada, fixing the rates of license tax upon the same and providing for the collection of said license tax, and a punishment for carrying on or conducting any such business without a license, and repealing Ordinances Nos. 1, 2, 4, 13, 14 and 35, Approved December 3, 1913, and amended Dec. 13, 1915 by Ordinance No. 62 of the City, and further amended March 6, 1919 by Ordinance No. 74 of the City of Las Vegas, and to amend section 6 of said Ordinance no. 48 as created by said Ordinance No. 74, and repealing all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith, and same was passed on motion of Commissioner Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Elwell, upon the following vote, Commissioners Anderson, Shield, Elwell and His Honor the Mayor W. C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

At the time the Clerk read for the first time the draft of proposed Ordinance No. 103 drawn up by the City Attorney as directed by the Board, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Section six (6) of Ordinance no. 77 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An Ordinance to Prohibit gaming in the City of Las Vegas, without first obtaining a license therefor, regulating the same, fixing the amount of such license, providing a penalty therefor, and repealing all Ordinances in conflict therewith, and to amend said Ordinance no. 77 by adding two new sections thereto to be known as sections 6a and 6b respectively, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with said amendments.
