At a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 28th day of January, A.D. 1924, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock P.M. Present His Honor the Mayor W.C. German with Commissioners F.E. Matzdorf, A.R. Anderson, C.R. Shield and W.H. Elwell, together with the City Attorney and the City Clerk.

At this time the Clerk read proof of posting and of publication of notice of intention to make street improvements, and there being no written objections to the proposed improvement of the 16 foot strip on each side of the proposed Federal Aid 18 foot strip on Fremont Street, of which notice had been given, it was ordered, on motion of Commissioner Elwell, seconded by Commissioner Shield, that the City attorney draft an ordinance for said improvement. Voting Commissioners Elwell, Shield, Matzdorf, and Anderson, and His Honor the Mayor, W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

It was ordered, on motion of Commissioner Matzdorf, seconded by Commissioner Elwell, that the City Clerk make application and arrangements for state industrial insurance for members of the volunteer fire department. Voting Commissioners Matzdorf, Shield, Elwell, and Anderson, and His Honor the Mayor, Aye. Noes, none.

It was ordered, on motion of Commissioner Elwell, seconded by Commissioner Matzdorf, that the salary of the City Treasurer be increased from the sum of Twenty-five (\$25) Dollars per month to the sum of Fifty (\$50) Dollars per month, commencing January 1st, 1924.

The vote on said motion was as follows: Commissioners Matsdorf, Anderson, Shield, Elwell, and His Honor the Mayor, W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

It was ordered, upon motion of Commissioner Matsdorf, seconded by Commissioner Elwell, that the City Clerk be instructed to notify in writing W.W. Rammels, who has a gambling license at the Arizona Club, that it is the order of the Board that he immediately comply with the provisions of Ordinance No. 108 in removing all obstructions to free the view from the outside to the interior of his place of business or his license will be revoked, and it is further ordered that he shall report to this Board at its next regular meeting to be held February 5th, 1924 at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock P.M. Voting Commissioners Matsdorf, Anderson, Shield and Elwell, and His Honor the Mayor, W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

Thereupon there being no further business to come before the Board at this time, it was ordered, upon motion duly made and carried, that the Board adjourn until the next regular meeting to be held on the 5th day of February, A.D. 1924, at the hour of seven thirty o'clock P.M. Voting Commissioners Matsdorf, Anderson, Shield, Elwell, and His Honor the Mayor, Aye. Noes, none.
