at a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, held on the 21st day of April A.D. 1924, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock p.m. Present His Honor the Mayor, W.C. German, with Commissioners F.E. Matzdorf, W.H. Elwell, A.A. Anderson and C.A. Shield, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk.

At this time a case appeared before the Board with regard to the purchase of additional fire equipment. Thereupon, on motion of Commissioner Shield seconded by Commissioner Anderson it was ordered that the Clerk be and she is hereby directed to order the supplies needed.

Thereupon the Clerk read for the second time proposed Ordinance No. 105 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An ordinance to amend subdivision number 19 of section 2 of ordinance No. 61 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Section Seven (7) of Ordinance No. 48 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas, licensing, for the purpose of regulation and revenue, every kind of lawful business hereinafter specified, transacted or carried on within the corporation limits of the City of Las Vegas, State of Nevada, fixing the rates of license tax upon the same and providing for the collection of said license tax, and a punishment for carrying on or conducting any such business without a license, and repealing Ordinance Nos. 1, 2, 4, 13, 14 and 35, approved December 3, 1913, and amended Dec. 13, 1915 by ordinance no. 62 of the City of Las Vegas, and further amended March 5, 1915 by Ordinance No. 74, and repealing all ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith." Whereupon it was ordered upon motion of Commissioner Anderson, seconded by Matzdorf, Commissioner that said Ordinance be passed, to take effect immediately after publication for one week (one issue) in the Las Vegas Review. Voting on said motion, Commissioners Matzdorf, Anderson, Shield, Elwell and His Honor the Mayor W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

This being the time set for hearing protests against the proposed sidewalk construction and it appearing that there are no protests whatsoever, Thereupon the Clerk read for the first time proposed Ordinance No. 106 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas providing for the improvement of Second Street by constructing cement and concrete sidewalk in front of Block Nos. 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 of Clark's Las Vegas Townsite, and providing for the payment therefor by special assessment."

Thereupon, on motion of Commissioner Matzdorf, seconded by Commissioner Shield, said proposed Ordinance was passed to the second reading, on the following vote: Commissioner Matzdorf, Anderson, Shield, Elwell and His Honor the Mayor W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

Thereupon, on motion of Commissioner Matzdorf, seconded by Commissioner Elwell, the Clerk was directed to publish a notice inviting bids for sidewalk construction. Voting Commissioners Matzdorf, Anderson, Shield, Elwell and His Honor the Mayor W.C. German Aye. Noes, none.

At this time the Clerk presented the application of James Germain for a gaming license for two games at the Lopez building on First Street, said application having been theretofore approved by Police and Fire Commissioner W.H. Elwell, it was thereupon ordered on motion of Commissioner Anderson seconded by Commissioner Shield that said gaming license for two games at the Lopez building on First Street be granted to said James Germain. Voting Commissioners Anderson, Shield, Elwell and His Honor the Mayor W.C. German, Aye. Commissioner Matzdorf, no.

There upon the Clerk presented the application of A.H. Bay for a gaming license for two games at the Arizona Club, the same having been theretofore approved by the Police and Fire Commissioner W.H. Elwell. After discussion of the matter it was ordered on motion of Commissioner Anderson that consideration of the matter be and the same is hereby continued until it is determined whether or not the City Ordinance relating to an unobstructed view of gaming rooms from the sidewalk, is being complied with. Voting Commissioners Matzdorf, Anderson, Shield, Elwell and His Honor the Mayor W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

At this time C.C. Boyer, Division Engineer of the Department of Highway of the State of Nevada, with estimates on the improvement of Main and Fremont streets under Federal Aid. After a thorough discussion of the matter the following resolution was duly adopted:

RESOLVED that provided that the total cost of the project does not exceed \$50,000.00, of which Federal Aid in the amount of \$28,000.00 will be received, the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, desires to proceed with the project as outlined, to-wit: the improvement of Fremont Street for the full fifty feet in addition to the eighteen foot gravel approach on main street, and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proceeds of the Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollar bond issue authorized, of which Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars have been sold, be applied towards paying for the City's Share of the Expense.

Said Resolution was duly adopted upon motion of Commissioner Shield, seconded by Commissioner Anderson, upon the following vote: Commissioners Matzdorf, Shield, Anderson and His Honor the Mayor, W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

At this time J.T. McWilliams appeared before the board with a plat of the proposed Valley View Addition to the City of Las Vegas, whereupon, the following resolution was duly adopted on motion of Commissioner Anderson, Seconded by Commissioner Shield:

RESOLVED that the Valley View Addition to the City of Las Vegas be and the same is hereby approved in accordance with the plat duly presented and that the Mayor and City Clerk of this City be and they are hereby directed to certify this approval on said plat. Voting Commissioners Matzdorf, Shield, Anderson and His Honor the Mayor, W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.

Thereupon, there being no further business to come before the Board at this time it was ordered on motion of Commissioner Shield, Seconded by Commissioner Matzdorf that the Board adjourn until the next regular meeting to be held on the 6th day of May, A.D. 1924, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock p.m. Voting Commissioners Anderson, Shield, Matzdorf and His Honor the Mayor W.C. German, Aye. Noes, none.
