Minutes of the previous regular meeting were read, and there being no omissions or corrections were approved as read.

Messrs. Harry Blanding, John F. Miller, J.S. Rhoads and Joe S. Smith appeared before the Board requesting the improvement of Main Street, presenting a petition which is on file with the Clerk of the Board. After considerable discussion the matter was taken under consideration by the Board.

It appearing to the Board that the Fire Department needs 100 feet of fire hose, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Bureau Fire Hose Company for the purchase of 1000 feet at \$1.50 per foot, payable on or before

the first of May, 1927.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, it was ordered, on motion of Commissioner Mundy, seconded by Commissioner Hammond, that the Board adjourn until the next regular meeting to be held on Thursday, the 3rd day of June, A.D. 1926, at the hour of three o'clock P.M.

At a regular meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 3rd day of June, A.D. 1926, at the hour of three o'clock P.M.

Present Hon. J.F. Hespe, Mayor, with Commissioners W.B. Mundy, C.J. Hammond, C.J. Smith and W.E. Elwell, together with the City Attorney and City Clerk.

At a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 17th day of June, A.D. 1926, at the hour of three o'clock P.M. Present Hon. J. F. Heese, Mayor with Commissioners W. B. Mundy, O. J. Smith and W. H. Elwell, together with the City Attorney and the City Clerk, Commissioner C. J. Hammond being absent.

At this time the Clerk presented a communication from Messrs. Cragin and Pike urging the passage of proposed ordinance No. 117 of the City of Las Vegas, said proposed ordinance having been read for the first time at a regular adjourned meeting of said Board held on the 21st day of April, 1926.

Thereupon the Clerk read for the second time proposed Ordinance No. 117 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 112 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled, "An Ordinance to license traveling shows, circuses, hippodromes, menageries and carnivals in the City of Las Vegas, and all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith." On motion of Commissioner Mundy, seconded by Commissioner Smith, said Ordinance was passed and adopted, and the Clerk was directed to have the same published for one week, one issue in the Las Vegas Age, a weekly newspaper published in said City of
