At this time the Clerk presented to the Board the assessment roll as prepared by the City Assessor for the sidewalk improvement on the east side of South Fourth Street, authorized by Ordinance No. 122; and, on motion of Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Kundy, and duly carried it was ordered that the Clerk publish the notice of assessment for a period of two weeks in the following form:

That the roll of special assessment heretofore made by the assessor for the purpose of defraying that part of the costs which the board decided should be paid and borne by special assessment for the construction of a cement concrete sidewalk on the East side of Fourth Street, in Blocks 39 and 40 of Clark's Las Vegas Townsite in said City of Las Vegas, is now on file at my office for public inspection. Notice is hereby given that the Board of City Commissioners and the assessor of the City of Las Vegas will meet in the Board of City Commissioners' room in this City on Tuesday, the 7th day of June, 1927, at the hour of three o'clock P. M. to review said assessment, at which time ~~the~~ place opportunity will be given all persons interested to be heard.
