At an adjourned regular meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 14th day of May, 1928, at the hour of three o'clock P. M. Present: His Honor, the Mayor, J. F. Hesse; Commissioners O. J. Smith, W. B. Kundy and W. C. German, together with the City Attorney and Clerk. Absent: Commissioner Roy Neagle.

Meeting called to order by the Mayor.

A draft of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance declaring the determination of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas to make certain improvements in the City of Las Vegas by grading for and constructing oil bound gravel pavements and hydraulic cement concrete curbs on certain streets and portions of streets in said City; describing definitely the location of said improvements; providing that the cost and expense thereof shall be paid entirely by special assessment upon all the lots included in the special assessment district, hereby established, according to benefits, except where, by the Charter of the City of Las Vegas certain portions thereof are required to be paid from the General Fund of said City of Las Vegas; providing for the issuance of special assessment bonds and also general bonds of the City of Las Vegas for the payment thereof and other matters relating thereto.", was read for the first time, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, was laid over for a second reading.

At this time a written report of estimates on the expense of a proposed pavement and curb improvement and plat thereof, designated as Las Vegas Special 1928 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement, heretofore directed to be proposed was presented by the Mayor, and upon motion, duly made, seconded and carried the said estimate and plat were approved and ordered filed in the office of the City Clerk for public examination.

Whereupon, a form of notice in connection with said proposed Las Vegas Special 1928 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement was presented by the City Attorney to the Board. Thereupon, on motion of Commissioner Kundy, seconded by Commissioner Smith, and duly carried, the following preambles and resolution were duly adopted:

WHEREAS, estimates of the expense of the proposed Las Vegas Special 1928 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement, and plat thereof, have been approved and filed with this Board for public examination, and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that the expenses of such improvement are to be defrayed by special assessment,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following notice be signed by the Mayor and attested by the Clerk with the seal of the City affixed thereto, and that notice be given of the approval and filing of such estimates and plat and of the proposed improvement, or work, of the location of the improvement, and of the district to be assessed, by the publication of such notice for at least two weeks in the Las Vegas Age, a tri-weekly newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, and by posting notices of the same in at least three public places in the one ward embracing said City, and also by posting a notice in or near the post office of the City, and posting notices in at least three public places near the site of said proposed work; that said notices shall state the time and place when and where the Board will meet and consider any suggestions and objections that may be made by parties in interest to the proposed improvements, which is hereby fixed at the Council Room of this Board in the County Court House in said City of Las Vegas at the hour of three o'clock P. M. on the 31st day of May, 1928; said notice being in words and figures as follows:

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PAVEMENT, AND CURB IMPROVEMENTS, IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS.

The Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, hereby give notice to all parties concerned and interested, and especially to those parties owning property in the district hereinafter designated to be assessed; that the said Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas intends to grade for and construct oil bound gravel pavements and hydraulic cement concrete curbs upon those certain streets and portions of streets hereinafter designated in accordance with plats, diagrams and estimates prepared on behalf of said City of Las Vegas and on file in the office of the City Clerk for public examination.

The streets and portions of streets on which said improvement is to be done and the location of the work to be done, follows:

To grade for and construct oil bound gravel pavements, fifty feet wide, and hydraulic cement concrete curb, on the following streets and portions of streets in said City of Las Vegas:

IN CLARK'S LAS VEGAS TOWNSITE.

First Street, from Stewart Street to Fremont Street.
 First Street, from Fremont Street to Lewis Street.
 Second Street, from Stewart Street to Fremont Street.
 Second Street, from Fremont Street to Lewis Street.
 Third Street, from Stewart Street to Fremont Street.
 Third Street, from Fremont Street to Lewis Street.
 Fourth Street, from Stewart Street, to Fremont Street.
 Fourth Street, from Fremont Street to Lewis Street.
 Fifth Street, from Stewart Street to Fremont Street.
 Ogden Street, from Main Street to the easterly limit of Fifth Street.
 Carson Street, from Main Street to Fifth Street.
 Bridger Street, from Main Street to Fifth Street.

IN HAWKINS ADDITION.

Ogden Street, from Fifth Street to the alley running northerly and southerly through Blocks 1 and 2 in said Hawkins Addition.
 Fremont Street, from Fifth Street to the easterly limit of said Hawkins Addition crossing said Fremont Street.
 Sixth Street, from alley running easterly and westerly through Blocks 2 and 7 in said Hawkins Addition to the alley running easterly and westerly through Blocks 3 and 6 in said Hawkins Addition.

IN BUCK'S SUBDIVISION

Fremont Street, from the westerly limit of said Buck's Subdivision crossing said Fremont Street, to Eighth Street. Seventh Street, from the northerly line of lot 5 in Block 3 and the northerly line of lot 5 in Block 4 in said Buck's Subdivision to the alley running easterly and westerly through Block 6 of Hawkins Addition to the West side of said Seventh Street and to the South line of the North half of lot 3 in Block 13 of said Buck's Subdivision on the east side of said Seventh Street.

That all the costs and expense of laying and constructing said oil bound gravel pavements and hydraulic cement concrete curbs and gutters, is to be defrayed by special assessment, to be made according to benefits, upon the taxable lots and premises situate in the Special assessment district composed of the following lands. to-wit:

IN CLARK'S LAS VEGAS TOWNSITE.

All lots in Blocks 1 (except lots 1 to 8, both numbers inclusive), 2 (except lots 9 to 16, both numbers inclusive) 3, 4, 5, (except lots 9 to 16, both numbers inclusive), 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, and 37 (the latter being Grammar School Block).

IN HAWKINS ADDITION.

Blocks 1 (except lots 17 to 32, both numbers inclusive), 2, (except lots 25 to 32, both numbers inclusive) 3 (except lots 15 to 30, both numbers inclusive) 6, (except lots 15 to 30, both numbers inclusive), and 7 (except lots 1 to 8, both numbers inclusive).

IN BUCK'S SUBDIVISION.

Blocks 3 (except lots 1 to 4, both numbers inclusive, and lot C), 12 (except lots 1 to 4, both numbers inclusive, and lots 13 to 16, both numbers inclusive), except where, by the Charter of the City of Las Vegas, a certain portions thereof are required to be paid from the General Fund of the City of Las Vegas.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby gives notice that A.D., on Thursday, the 31st day of May, 1928, at the hour of 3 o'clock P. M., in the Council Room (also known as Room of County Commissioners), at the County Court House, in the City of Las Vegas, it will hold a meeting for the purpose of considering any suggestions or objections that may be made by parties interested with respect to the proposed improvements.
