At an adjourned regular meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 18th day of July, 1928, at the hour of three o'clock P. M. Present Hon. J. F. Hesse, Mayor; Commissioners Mundy and German, together with the City Attorney and Clerk; Commissioners Neagle and Smith being absent.

Meeting called to order by the Mayor.

A draft of an Ordinance entitled: "An ordinance to regulate the construction, equipment and appliances of buildings and premises used for theatrical and motion picture exhibitions, and to regulate the operation of such equipment and appliances, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith," was read for the first time and upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, it was laid over for a second reading.

No further business appearing the meeting was adjourned.

At a regular meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 2nd day of August, 1928, at the hour of three o'clock P. M. Present: His Honor, the Mayor, J.F. Hesse; Commissioners C. J. Smith, W. B. Mundy, W. C. German together with the City Attorney and Clerk. Absent: Commissioners O. J. Smith and LeRoy Neagle.

Meeting called to order by the Mayor.

All claims allowed as shown by the Claims and Warrants Register on file in the office of the Clerk.

Reports of City Officers read, approved and ordered filed in the office of the Clerk.

Minutes of previous regular and adjourned meetings read and approved.

Owing to the absence of Commissioner Smith, ~~Deputy~~ Commissioner, His Honor, the Mayor, appointed Commissioner Mundy to audit the Street department bills, and the Mayor also appointed Commissioner German to audit the

Police and Fire Department bills, owing to the absence of Commissioner Neagle.

Thereupon a proposed ordinance entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, to borrow <sup>Twelve</sup> ~~ten~~ Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00), to provide funds for the purpose of defraying that portion of the expenses determined by said Board of Commissioners to be stood and borne by the City of Las Vegas for the grading for and construction of Oil bound gravel pavements and hydraulic cement concrete curbs upon interior squares or spaces formed by the intersection of streets and spaces opposite alleys and where lands belonging to said City or public ground not taxable, abut on such improvements, in connection with those certain improvements authorized and determined to be made under the provisions of Ordinance No. 131 of the City of Las Vegas; to issue and sell the bonds of the City of Las Vegas therefore, said bonds to be known as "Las Vegas Special 1928 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement Bonds, Series A," and providing for the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds and other matters relating thereto," was read for the first time. Upon motion duly made seconded and carried it was laid over for a second reading.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the following Preambles and Resolution were duly adopted:

Whereas, it appears from the estimates of the cost of estimates of the cost of Las Vegas Special 1928 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement, on file with the City Clerk, which improvements have been ordered under the terms of Ordinance No. 131 of the City of Las Vegas, approved July 5, 1928, that the cost of the grading for the construction of the oil bound gravel pavements and hydraulic concrete curbs upon the interior squares or spaces formed by the intersection of streets and spaces opposite alleys and where land belonging to the City or public ground not taxable abut on such improvements will be in the sum of \$9,465.15, or more, and that it will be necessary to issue general bonds of the City of Las Vegas to defray the portion of such costs and expenses as may be determined by this board to be stood and borne by said City,

*wld* NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in the opinion of this board ~~Ten~~ <sup>Twelve</sup> Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) of the cost thereof is justly apportionable to such public grounds, and City property, and to interior squares or space formed by the intersection of streets where the abutting property is taxable, and that such cost up to the sum of \$10,000 be paid from a district street fund to be raised by the sale of general bonds of the City in the par value of \$10,000, and that the balance of such cost and expense be assessed upon all the land included in the special assessment district, as defined by said Ordinance No. 131, in proportion to the estimated benefits resulting thereto from the improvement.

*wld* It was ordered, upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, that the moneys collected by the City Clerk, Municipal Judge, and Plumbing Inspector, for licences, fines and Plumbing inspection fees, totaling \$2,371.75, be apportioned as follows, the sum of \$23.23 to the Water Sewer and Light Fund, the sum of \$1782.85 to the General Fund and the sum of \$565.65, to the Police and Fire Fund; further ordered that the sum of \$1,000.00 be transferred from the General Fund to the Water Sewer and Light ~~fund~~ <sup>assessment</sup>.

No further business occurring it was ordered, upon motion duly made, seconded and carried that a recess be declared, until Monday the 6th day of July, 1928, at the hour of three o'clock P. M.
