W.B. ✓ The Clerk then read to the Board a letter from Roger Foley, Esq., Justice of the Peace in and for Las Vegas Township, Clark County, Nevada, requesting that he be appointed to the office of Municipal Judge of the City of Las Vegas. Thereupon, upon motion of Commissioner Mundy, seconded by Commissioner Neagle, it was by the Board ordered that the said Roger Foley, Esq., be, and he hereby is appointed to the office of Municipal Judge of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, contingent upon his filing a good and sufficient Bond in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); said Bond to be approved by the Mayor. Further ordered that upon subscribing to and filing with the constitutional Oath of Office that the said Roger Foley immediately take office as said Municipal Judge.
