

"An Ordinance Authorizing The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, to Borrow Forty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars and Eighty-eight Cents to Cover Certain Unpaid Assessments Heretofore Levied and Confirmed By The Board Of Commissioners Of The City Of Las Vegas For The Purpose Of Paying For The Work Of Making Improvements In The City Of Las Vegas, By Constructing Oil Bound Gravel Pavements And Hydraulic Cement Concrete Curbs On Certain Streets And Portions Of Streets In Said City, To-wit: - On First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Fifth Street, Ogden Street, Carson Street, Bridger Street and Fremont Street, To Issue And Sell The Bonds Of The City Of Las Vegas Therefor, Said Bonds To Be Known As "Las Vegas Special 1929 Pavement And Curb Street Improvement Bonds", And Providing For The Collection Of Said Unpaid Assessments By Dividing The Same Into Ten (10) Annual Installments And Placing Said Installments On The Tax Roll Of Clark County And Collecting Same In The Same Manner As State And County Taxes Are Collected By Law"

was read for the second time, and upon motion duly made, and seconded, was duly passed, approved and adopted, and FURTHER ORDERED that said ordinance be numbered 134, and that said ordinance be published in the "LAS VEGAS AGE", a tri-weekly newspaper, published in the ^{City of Las Vegas} County of Clark, for a period of one week. Vote on said resolution was as follows: Commissioners E. B. Mundy, Roy Neagle, O. J. Smith, W. C. German and His Honor, the Mayor, J. F. Hesse, voting aye; Noes, none.

At a recessed regular meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 11th day of March, 1929, at the hour of seven-thirty P. M.

PRESENT: W. B. Mundy, Mayor Pro tem; Commissioners W. C. German and Roy Neagle, together with the City Attorney and Clerk.

ABSENT: His Honor the Mayor, J. F. Hesse and Commissioner O. J. Smith.

Meeting called to order by W. B. Mundy, Mayor Pro tem.

At this time the Board took up the matter of providing for the General City Election, to be held on May 7th 1929, for the purpose of electing two commissioners and a city clerk for the City of Las Vegas. Upon motion by Commissioner German, seconded by Commissioner Neagle, the following preamble and resolution was duly adopted:

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter I, of the Charter of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, as amended by the Legislature of the State of Nevada in the year 1927, a General City Election must be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in every odd numbered year from and after the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May 1913, and it appearing therefrom that such General City Election, for said City of Las Vegas, must be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May, 1929, to-wit: On the 7th day of May, 1929, and it further appearing that preparation for such election should be made at this time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a General City Election be, and the same is hereby ordered to be held in said City of Las Vegas on said 7th day of May, 1929, at the time and for the purposes aforesaid, at the places hereinafter set forth;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the purpose of complying with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter II of said charter of said City of Las Vegas, as amended in 1923, said City of Las Vegas be, and it hereby is, divided into five election precincts as follows, to-wit: Precinct No. 1, which shall extend from the center line of Ogden Street south to center line of Carson Street, and west from the center line of Fifth Street to the west city limits; Precinct No. 2, which shall extend south from the center line of Carson Street to the center line of Clark Street, and

west from the center line of Fifth Street to the west city limits; Precinct No. 3, which shall extend south from the center line of Clark Street to the south city limits, and west from the center line of Fifth Street to the west city limits; Precinct No. 4, which shall extend east from the center line of Fifth Street to the east city limits; Precinct No. 5, which shall extend north from the center line of Ogden Street to the North city limits;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the polling places in said election precincts shall be established as follows, to-wit: For Precinct No. 1, at the City Fire House situated on Lot 23 in Block 15, in Clark's Las Vegas Townsite; for Precinct No. 2 at the building known as the Public Library Building, situated on Block 20 of said Clark's Las Vegas Townsite; for Precinct No. 3 at the garage of Ed W. Clark Forwarding Co. situated on the rear of lot 26 in Block 7 of said Clark's Las Vegas Townsite; for precinct No. 4, in the rear room of the Latter Day Saints' Church on the N. W. corner of 6th & Carson Streets; for precinct No. 5, at the Lou Martin Garage on rear of lot 17, Block 32, Clark's Las Vegas Townsite, N. W. corner of Fourth and Ogden Streets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the inspectors and clerks of election for each of said election precincts shall be as follows, to-wit:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no candidate for office at such election shall be entitled to have his name placed upon the official ballot unless such candidate shall, not more than 50 days nor less than 30 days before the date of election, file in the office of the City Clerk of said City of Las Vegas, Nevada, a petition of nomination, in writing, containing the name of the person nominated, the office for which he is nominated, and setting forth his qualifications as required by Section 6 of Chapter II of the city charter of said City of Las Vegas, Nevada. Such petition shall be subscribed and sworn to by the candidate nominated; and there shall be charged each candidate, for filing such petition of nomination, a fee of \$5.00, which shall be paid to the City Clerk at the time of filing and go to the General fund of said City;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk of said City of Las Vegas be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to notify the County Clerk of Clark County, Nevada, to open registration for the registration of voters of said City of Las Vegas for said General City Election at the time, and in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Nevada, governing the registration of voters, such registration to open on the 16th day of March, 1929 and close on the 17th day of April, 1929;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk of said City of Las Vegas be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to have official ballots prepared and to do and perform all such other or further acts, and give such notices as may be necessary or required by the charter of said city or by the general election laws of the State of Nevada, in order that said election may be called and held, and that the qualified voters of said city may have due notice thereof;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all provisions of the general election laws of the State of Nevada, so far as the same may be applicable and not inconsistent with the said City Charter of the said City of Las Vegas, shall be observed in conducting said election;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, or Mayor Pro tem, of said City of Las Vegas be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to issue a proclamation giving notice of the holding of said election, such proclamation to contain the substance of this resolution, and such other matters as may be necessary, to fully and fairly apprise the qualified voters of said City of Las Vegas of the date, time, places of holding and purposes of said election, the names of inspectors and clerks, the method and manner of classifying the commissioners on ballots and such other matters as may be deemed proper in the premises;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such proclamation be published in the Las Vegas Age, a tri-weekly newspaper, printed and published in the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, for one publication not less than six weeks prior to the date of such election, and that printed copies of such proclamation be posted forthwith by the City Clerk of said City in not less than three conspicuous places in each election precinct.

The vote on foregoing motion and resolution was as follows: Commissioners German and Keagle and Mayor Pro tem Mundy, Aye; Hoos, None.

The Clerk next read a letter from Dr. W. S. Park, President of the City Planning Commission, which was referred to the Mayor for consideration.

The Clerk thereupon read a letter to the Board from one Carol Aronovici, relative to suggestions for city planning. After due consideration, this was ordered filed.

At this time C. D. Baker appeared before the Board and requested approval of plat of East Vegas View Tract and replat of Lot "L" of Park Place Addition to the City of Las Vegas. Both of said plats and also plat of Las Vegas Highland, Unit No. 1, were referred to the City Planning Commission.

No further business appearing at this time a recess was declared until Wednesday evening, March 13th, at the hour of 7:30 P. M.

At a recessed regular meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, held on the 13th day of March, 1929, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock, P. M.

PRESENT: W. B. Mundy, Mayor pro tem; Commissioners W. C. German and O. J. Smith, together with the City Attorney and Clerk.

ABSENT: His Honor, the Mayor, J. F. Hesse and Commissioner Roy Neagle.

Meeting called to order by Mr. Mundy, Mayor pro tem.

Upon motion of Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner German, it was moved to revise that portion of the minutes of the meeting of March 5, 1929, pertaining to the acceptance of the bid of Roche-Axman Company so as to read as follows:

Upon motion of Commissioner Mundy, seconded by Commissioner Neagle, it was moved that the bid of Roche-Axman Company for construction of oil bound gravel pavement and hydraulic cement concrete curbs on certain streets in the City of Las Vegas in accordance with Ordinance No. 151, be accepted; that the Mayor or Mayor pro tem and the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk be authorized to enter into said contract on behalf of the city, upon the furnishing of a good and sufficient bond provided in the specifications and general conditions and contract, such bond to be approved by the Board of City Commissioners.

A replat of Lot "L" of Park Place Addition of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, said owners being Floy A. Gibson and Eva W. Gibson, was presented to the Board for approval. It appearing to the Board that said plat is in proper form, it was by the Board ordered, upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, that the Mayor pro tem approve said plat and the City Clerk attest the same.

Upon motion of Commissioner Mundy, seconded by Commissioner German, it was moved that a lease be entered into with the Austin-Western Road Machinery Company and the City of Las Vegas, for the purchase of one Wheel Grader; that the Mayor pro tem be authorized to sign same and the Deputy City Clerk to attest same. Vote on said resolution was as follows: Commissioners W. C. German and O. J. Smith, and W. B. Mundy, Mayor pro tem, aye; Nones; none.

At this time Mr. P. A. Simon appeared before the Board relative to an air-port for the city. This matter was discussed at some length and finally laid over for future consideration.

No further business appearing at this time a recess was declared until Friday evening, March 15th, 1929, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock, P. M.
