Bids will be opened by said Board of Commissioners on the 22nd day of April, 1929, at _____ o'clock _____ M. at the regular meeting place of said Board in the Board of Commissioners Room in the County Court House in said City of Las Vegas. Bidders shall submit a bid specifying (a) the lowest rate of interest and premium, if any, above par, at which such bidder will purchase said bonds; or (b) the lowest rate of interest at which the bidder will purchase said bonds at par. The bonds will be sold to the bidder making the best bid subject to the right of said Board of Commissioners to reject any and all bids and readvertise. None of said bonds will be sold at less than par and accrued interest, and no discount or commission will be allowed or paid on the sale of such bonds.
