All claims allowed as shown by Claims and Warrants Register on file in the office of the Clerk; reports read and approved.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and carried it was ordered that monies collected by the City Clerk, Municipal Judge and Plumbing Inspector, for licenses, fines and fees respectively, totaling \$4833.00, be apportioned as follows:- To the Police & Fire Fund, \$2375.00; to the General Fund, \$2375.00; to the Water, Sewer & Light Fund, \$83.00.
