Minutes of a recessed regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, State of Nevada, held at the Board Room of said Board in the County Courthouse in the City of Las Vegas on this 17th day of May, 1929 at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M.

Present: Mayor Pro. Tem. W. B. Mundy, Commissioners C. J. Smith, W. C. German, the City Clerk and City Attorney.

Absent: Mayor J. F. Hesse and Commissioner Roy Neagle.

The City Clerk presented to the Board the printed forms of bonds authorized by the terms of Ordinance No. 134 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled: "An Ordinance Authorizing the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada to borrow Forty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy eight dollars and eighty-eight cents to cover certain unpaid assessments heretofore levied and confirmed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas for the purpose of paying for the work of making improvements in the City of Las Vegas, by constructing oil bound gravel pavements and hydraulic cement concrete curbs on certain streets and portions of streets in said City, to-wit:-On First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Fifth Street, Ogden Street, Carson Street, Bridger Street and Fremont Street, to issue and sell the bonds of the City of Las Vegas therefor, said bonds to be known as 'Las Vegas Special 1929 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement Bonds', and providing for the collection of said unpaid assessments by dividing the same into ten (10) annual installments and placing said installments on the tax roll of Clark County and collecting same in the same manner as state and county taxes are collected by law". The Clerk stated that the transcript of the proceedings relative to said bond issue had been prepared and that the bonds were ready for the approval of the Board and for the official signatures of the officers provided by law for the signing of the same.

Thereupon, upon motion of Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner German, the following Preambles and Resolution were duly adopted upon the affirmative vote of Commissioners German and Smith and Mayor Pro. Tem. Mundy, - Nones none, to-wit:

Whereas, under and by virtue of the terms of Ordinance No. 134 of the City of Las Vegas there has been prepared and are now ready for official signature and issuance fifty bonds to be known as "Las Vegas Special 1929 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement Bonds," as follows: Forty Bonds of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000) each, and Ten (10) bonds of the denomination of Three Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars and Eighty-eight cents; four of said bonds of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000) each and one (1) bond of the denomination of Three Hundred Seventy-seven dollars and eighty-eight cents (\$377.88) each, payable at annual periods of from one to ten years from January 1, 1929, each bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed seven per cent per annum, to-wit: Six and one-half per cent (6½%) per annum; said interest to be payable annually on the first day of January of each, year, and

Whereas, The said bonds are numbered from One (1) to fifty (50) consecutively, and bear interest at the rate of six and one-half per cent (6½%) per annum, payable annually on the first day of January of each year at the office of the City Treasurer of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada and are dated January 1, 1929, and are made due and payable according to their consecutive numbers, as follows:

Bonds Nos. 1 to 4 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1930. Bond No. 5 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1930. Bonds Nos. 6 to 9 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1931. Bond No. 10 for \$377.88, on the first day

of January, 1931. Bonds Nos. 11 to 14 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1932. Bond No. 15 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1932. Bonds Nos. 16 to 19 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1933. Bond No. 20 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1933. Bonds Nos. 21 to 24 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1934. Bond No. 25 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1934. Bonds Nos. 26 to 29 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1935. Bond No. 30 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1935. Bonds Nos. 31 to 34 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1936. Bond No. 35 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1936. Bonds Nos. 36 to 39 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1937. Bond No. 40 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1937. Bonds Nos. 41 to 44 inclusive for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1938. Bond No. 45 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1938. Bonds Nos. 46 to 49 inclusive, for \$1000 each, on the first day of January, 1939. Bond No. 50 for \$377.88, on the first day of January, 1939, and

Whereas, the payment and redemption of said bonds will be in the order of their issuance, the lowest bond to be the first paid and redeemed, and so on until the whole amount of said bonds so authorized to be issued shall have been paid and redeemed, and

Whereas, each of said bonds have coupons attached representing each interest installment to date of maturity of the principal, and both principal and interest of said bonds are made payable in Gold Coin of the United States of America, at the office of the City Treasurer of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, and

Whereas, the said bonds as so prepared, with the coupons thereon, with the necessary variations as to the numbers and maturities, are in the following forms, respectively, to-wit:

Las Vegas Special 1929 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement Bond

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the City of Las Vegas, a Municipal Corporation, existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Nevada, for value received, acknowledges itself indebted to, and hereby binds itself and promises to pay to the bearer One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in gold coin of the United States of America, at the office of the City Treasurer of said City, in the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, on the ___ day of _____, 19___, with interest thereon from date hereof at the rate of six and one-half per cent (6½%) per annum until paid; said interest payable annually on the 1st day of January of each year hereafter, during the term of this bond, upon the presentation and surrender of the proper coupons as they severally become due and payable, both principal and interest payable in gold coin of the United States of America, at the office of the City Treasurer, in the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada.

This bond is one of a series of fifty bonds as follows: Forty (40) bonds of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each, payable in ten (10) annual installments of four bonds each, commencing on the 1st day of January, A. D., 1930, and ten (10) bonds of the denomination of Three Hundred Seventy-seven and 88/100 Dollars (\$377.88) payable in ten (10) annual installments, commencing on the 1st day of January, A. D. 1930.

Four (4) bonds of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) each, together with the interest thereon, to be paid on the 1st day of January, A. D. 1930, and four (4) bonds of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) each, together with the interest thereon to be paid on the 1st day of January of each year thereafter, and one (1) bond of the denomination of Three Hundred Seventy Seven and 88/100 Dollars (\$377.88), together with the interest thereon, to be paid on the first day of January, A. D. 1930, and one (1) bond of the denomination of Three Hundred Seventy Seven and 88/100 Dollars (\$377.88), together with the interest thereon, to be paid on the 1st day of January of each year thereafter, and continuing until all of said bonds, together with the interest thereon are fully paid; authorized by virtue of the provisions of the authority contained in that certain Act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, entitled "An Act to authorize municipalities to issue bonds for the purpose of paying the cost of municipal improvements for which special assessments are levied," approved March 13, 1909, as amended by an Act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, entitled, "An Act to amend sections one and two of an Act entitled, 'An Act to authorize municipalities to issue bonds for the purpose of paying the cost of municipal improvements for which special assessments are levied,' approved March 13, 1909, and other matters relating thereto," approved March 13, 1913, and of City Ordinance No. 131 of the City of Las Vegas approved July 5, 1928 and City Ordinance No. 133 of the City of Las Vegas, approved October 30, 1928, and City Ordinance No. 134 of the City of Las Vegas, approved March 8, 1929, and of the proceedings of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, State of Nevada, had and taken under and by virtue of the provisions of the said Acts of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, and of the City Charter of the City of Las Vegas, and said Ordinances.

It is here certified that all of the acts, things and conditions required to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have been done, happened and performed as required by law, and in the event that the Fund created by special assessment as in said Ordinances Nos. 131, 133, and 134 of the City of Las Vegas contained, shall be insufficient to pay this bond in full, as the same becomes due, together with the interest thereon, the deficiency shall be paid by the City of Las Vegas out of its General Fund, and the City of Las Vegas thus binds itself.

This bond shall be known as "Las Vegas Special 1929 Pavement and Curb Street Improvement Bond", and shall be exempt from taxation by the City of Las Vegas.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City of Las Vegas, has by proper Resolution of its Board of City Commissioners caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and this bond to be signed by its Mayor and the City Clerk and countersigned by its City Assessor and the coupons hereunto attached to be authenticated by the signature of the City Assessor, in the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, this 1st day of January, A. D. 1929.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the bonds in the form aforesaid, as presented to the Board at this meeting be approved as to form and substance, and that the said bonds and each of them be signed by the Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, and the City Clerk, and countersigned by the City Assessor and authenticated by the seal of the City of Las Vegas, and by the Clerk of this Board delivered forthwith to the City Treasurer of the City of Las Vegas and by him delivered to the said purchaser upon the receipt of the purchase price as heretofore determined upon the acceptance of the bid of the said Snow Goodart & Co.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk certify to a copy of the minutes of this meeting and furnish such certified copy under the seal of said City to the purchaser of said bonds.

There being no further business before the meeting at this time, upon motion of Commissioner German, seconded by Commissioner Smith and duly carried the meeting was recessed until Monday the 20th day of May, 1929 at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M.
