There upon an Ordinance regulation the collection and fixing and establishing rates and compensations to be collected by any person, company or corporation collection garbage in the City of Las Vegas, and repealing Ordinance No. 80 of the City of Las Vegas. entitled:

"An Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas Regulating the Storage, and Removal of Garbage, and Offal, and Refuse, Animal, and Vegetable Matter," approved January 6th, 1928 and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith" was read for a second time and passed at a regular recessed meeting of the Board of City Commissioners on the 5th day of July 1929, upon the following vote: Commissioners Hansell, German, Smith, and Thomas, and His Honor the Mayor voting Aye.
