✓ An Ordinance empowering, authorizing and directing the ex-officio Assessor of the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, to levy a special assessment to defray the costs of making certain improvements in the City of Las Vegas, by constructing, erecting, and installing an ornamental street lighting system complete, including conduits, cables, standards, lighting units and all appurtenances thereto on certain streets and portions of streets in said City, according to plats, diagrams and estimates of cost thereof on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas; describing definitely the location of said improvements, stating the amounts of said assessment, and designating the lots, lands and premises to be assessed according to benefits providing for the payment thereof, and other matters relating thereto, was read to the Board for a first time.

✓ A letter from Mr. A. E. Cahlan of the Las Vegas Review was read to the Board in regards to the condition of the sidewalk in front of the Review Building. The Clerk was directed to notify Commissioner O. J. Smith, Street Commissioner to have same placed in repair.

The design, and estimate of a new sewer system as prepared by the Nevada Engineering and Construction Service Corp. was read to the Board. Also the estimate of King & Malone of Reno in regards to the same matter.

✓ A Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Smith, and Seconded by Commissioner Thomas that the City relinquish its right to the section of land held for an airport so that the Western Air Express might lease same from the Department of the Interior to be used for and air port.
