

Upon motion duly made seconded, and carried the Mayor J. F. Hesse, and Commissioner O.J. Smith were each allowed forty-five (45) days leaf of absence.

An Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, mowing, removal, demolition, conversion, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, and maintenance of all buildings and /or structures in the City of Las Vegas; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; providing penalties for the violation thereof; declaring, and establishing fire zones; repealing Ordinances Nos. Twenty-seven (27) Fifty-nine (59), Sixty-one (61) and Seventy-two (72) of the City of Las Vegas, and all other Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith; ✓

Was read for a second time, and passed by the following vote: Commissioners Smith, and Thomas, and His Honor the Mayor voting Aye. Ross None. The same was ordered published in the Las Vegas Review, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.

The Clerk was directed to order twenty-(20) copies of the Uniform Building Code, and have same on sale in the Clerk's Office. Three (3) copies to placed on file with the map of the fire zones all to be dated this 1st day of August 1929.

An Ordinance providing the manner of parking vehicles in certain areas of the City of Las Vegas for a period of sixty days from, and after the passage, approval, and complete publication of this ordinance, providing a penalty for the violation of this ordinance, and other matters relating thereto; was read for a second time, and passed by the following vote: Commissioners Smith, and Thomas, and His Honor the Mayor Voting Aye. Ross None. Same was ordered published in the Las Vegas Age, a tri-weekly newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas. ✓
