The bond of W. G. Morse, Municipal Judge was presented to the Board. Same being approved by the Mayor J. F. Hesse. The bond a surety bond being furnished by W. H. Elwell, and Ed VonTobel for the sum of \$2,000.00.

There upon motion of Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Thomas it was moved that the Board accept the bond of W. G. Morse.
