Application of one Neal Campbell was presented to the Board and same was referred to Police and Fire Commissioner Thomas.

A letter from John A. Shafer in regards to the application for a gas permit presented to the Board a short time ago was next read. The Clerk was directed to acknowledge receipt of same, and inform Mr. Shafer that the Board was awaiting his personal appearance before the Board before taking any action on same.

A letter from the John R. Davies Co. asking for the final payment of One Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$190.00) on the Ornamental Street Light System installed on Main, Fifth and Fremont Streets.
