Hesse voting Aye. Nies None. Same was ordered published for one week three issues in the Las Vegas Age a tri-weekly newspaper printed and published in the City of Las Vegas.

Commissioner Smith was granted a thirty day leave of absence.

Upon subjection of Commissioner German it was ordered that a joint meeting with the County Board of Commissioners be arranged for to discuss the request that the City Board give up the office of the City Clerk in County Commissioners room in the County Court House.

A communication from the Chamber of Commerce relative to duplication in names of streets was read and ordered filed.
