

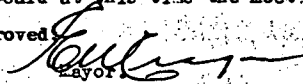

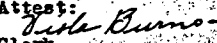
Vote on said motion was as follows: Commissioners Mundy, German and Hansell and His Honor the Mayor voting Aye. Noes none.

The Board at this time considered the passing of a new license Ordinance, and the entitled Ordinance, "An Ordinance to amend Section 7, of Ordinance No. 48 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled, "An Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas, licensing, for the purpose of regulation and revenue, every kind of lawful business hereinafter specified, transacted or carried on within the corporate limits of the City of Las Vegas, State of Nevada, fixing the rates of license tax upon the same and providing for the collection of said license tax, and a punishment for the carrying on or conducting any such business without a license, and repealing Ordinances Nos. 1, 2, 4, 13, 14, and 35," as amended by Sec. 1. of Ordinance No. 81 of said City, by herein amending certain subdivisions thereof and by adding certain other subdivisions, and to amend said Ordinance No. 48 by adding two new Sections to be know as Sections Nos. 10a and 10b respectively, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," was read for a first time and laid over for a second reading.

No further business appearing before the Board at this time the meeting then adjourned.

Minutes of a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, held on the 4th day of December, 1931 at the hour of three o'clock P.M.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Cragin, Commissioners, Mundy, German, and Thomas, City Attorney Stevens, and City Clerk Viola Burns.

Absent Commissioner Hansell.

Commissioner Mundy appointed to approve the bills of the W.S. & L. Dept. owing to the Commissioner of that dept. L.B. Hansell.

All claims allowed as per claims and warrant register on file in the office of the Clerk.

Reports of the Municipal Judge and City Clerk approved.

Monies received for the month of November as follows:

The sum of \$2,100.00 transferred from the General Fund to the W.S. & L. Fund.

Petitions from Cora J. Nobblitt and A.J. Robinson asking the Board for permission to use streets and alleys for the installing of water systems were presented to the Board and same were referred to J.P. King Street Supt.

"An Ordinance to amend, revise, and re-enact Sections Nos. 2 and 10 of Ordinance No. 111 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled, "An Ordinance prohibiting the manufacture, storage, or keeping, sale, offering or exposing for sale or barter, or other disposal of intoxicating liquors in the City of Las Vegas, regulating other matters pertaining thereto; providing a penalty for the violation of this ordinance, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," approved May 5, 1925, as amended by Ordinance No. 179; and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," was read for a first time and laid over for a second reading.

A petition to the Honorable Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas from the Beauty Parlor owners petitioning the Board to reduce the license fee for beauty parlors was presented to the Board.

Said petition will be considered at the time of the passing of the new license ordinance now under consideration.

On motion of Commissioner Mundy, seconded by Commissioner German it was moved that the Clerk be directed to take up as many of the Boulder Dam Highway Bonds as there was money in the treasury to cover same in units of One Thousand Dollars each plus the interest.

Vote on said motion was as follows: Commissioners Mundy, German, Thomas and His Honor the Mayor voting Aye. Noes none.

Mr. Tom Salter appeared before the Board in regard to the extension of time granted the Nevada Gas Company Ltd. for the installation of gas mains and ask that the company be granted a six month extension of time.

Thereupon, on motion, duly made, seconded and carried the following Resolution was duly adopted:

RESOLVED, that the application of said Nevada Gas Company, Ltd. be and the same is hereby granted and the time within which to complete the unfinished lines be and the same is hereby extended for a period of six months from the 15th day of December, 1931, and that this Resolution, when assented to by said Permittee Corporation be considered and treated as an amendment to that extent of said original permit, and that in all other respect said Original Permit shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that before the extension hereby provided shall take effect the said permittee corporation shall within twenty days from the 4th day of December, 1931, file in writing with the City Clerk a written acceptance of the terms of this Resolution executed by its proper officers under the seal of said corporation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall furnish a copy of this Resolution to said Nevada Gas Company, Ltd.

Vote on said motion was as follows: Commissioners Mundy, German, and Thomas and His Honor the Mayor voting Aye. Noes none.
