MINUTES
UTILITY COORDINATION COMMITTEE
March 11, 1976

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Gordon at 9:05 a. m. in the Central Telephone Company Conference Room with the following members present:

MINUTES: Upon a motion by Mr. Welsh, seconded by Mr. Paulk, the minutes of the meeting of February 4, 1976 were unanimously approved.

Mr. Emmett arrived.

POLICY
DISCUSSION:

The One-Number Calling System was discussed. An ad will be placed in Central Telephone Company's new telephone book listing numbers to call before digging. Mrs. Audrey Miller, Centel Commercial Department, presented an illustrated ad and requested correct numbers of interested parties for listing. Mr. Emmett was appointed Chairman of a subcommittee to supply Mrs. Miller with necessary information.

REVISION OF
STANDARD
SPECIFICATIONS:

Mr. Gordon Brockway discussed the revisions being made in the Standard Specifications for Off-Site Improvements in the Clark County area.

1. Scope of Standards - No conclusions have been arrived on the first portion.
2. In "Definition of Terms", N.E.C. National Code and N.O.S.H.A. were added.
3. On Page 20 - In the third paragraph - at least two working days before entering on the work, the contractor shall notify the utility owners to mark or otherwise indicate the location of subsurface facilities.

4. In the fourth paragraph - (addition) Including service connections - of which approximate locations have been marked by respective owners.
5. Page 141 - On the Use of Explosives - The contractor shall notify each public utility company having stretches of pipelines in proximity to the site of the work in which he intends to use explosives. Such notice shall be given in writing a week in advance to enable the companies to take such steps as they may deem necessary to protect their property from injury.
6. Joint Trenching - being referred to Regional Streets and Highway Commission Technical Committee for review.
7. Joint Backfill - being referred to Regional Streets and Highway Commission Technical Committee for review.
8. Pollution Control - (On Page 471) - "and such work must meet Health Board regulations", shall be added at the end of the first sentence.
9. Specifications agree with Statement.

A.P.W.A. WORKSHOP: Mr. Welsh reported on the American Public Works Association held in San Francisco. Two of the most common problems of utility companies is pavement restoration and trench backfill. It was a mutual agreement that the trench backfill was a workmanship - type problem with inspection. Most specifications are adequate as long as they are adhered to.

The One-Number Calling System was discussed at the workshop. Various methods of funding have proven successful. A standard method of recording damage when dig-ins occur provides information on savings benefits of utility companies and also provides names of contractors and utilities involved in dig-in damages.

Common use of crews on joint trenching projects provide savings for utilities.

Mr. Welsh urged members to attend workshops to gain valuable information.

A new method of billing with computers installed in vans was illustrated.

Obtaining authority for Utility Committee members to act for companies eliminates delay on projects.

Enabling legislature requiring the operation of a one-number calling system should be drafted in the near future by utility members to be presented at the 1977 meeting of the State Legislature.

Mr. Richard Breedlove, Chairman of the One-Number Calling System, was appointed Chairman of a Subcommittee to research material for legislative action. Mr. Gordon, Mr. Emett, and Mr. Welsh are other members of the Subcommittee.

PROJECTS:

Mr. Castleberry read a letter from the State Highway Department announcing that repaving of Las Vegas Boulevard from Oakey Boulevard to Dunes Avenue, and on Sahara Avenue from Las Vegas Boulevard to Paradise Road will begin on May 1, 1976.

Within two weeks, utilities will be receiving preliminary plans on the Maryland Parkway structure over Flamingo Wash. Construction is scheduled to begin during June.

Traffic signals will be installed at the intersections of Paradise Road and Harmon Avenue; Harmon Avenue and Las Vegas Boulevard South; and Nellis Boulevard and Lake Mead Boulevard.

These projects are being designed by Clark County Engineering Department and funded by the Nevada Highway Department and the Regional Street and Highway Department on a fifty-fifty cost basis. Construction must be underway by July 1, 1976.

Design is continuing on Swenson Street between Desert Inn Road and Tropicana Avenue. This project will include an assessment district. Preliminary plans should be completed within two months with construction scheduled for July 1, 1976.

Construction of the Tropicana Avenue Project should be completed by mid-June.

The construction of Cheyenne Avenue between Civic Center Drive and Las Vegas Boulevard North, including Pecos Road between Las Vegas Boulevard North and Cheyenne Avenue has been requested for high priority on the Regional Street and Highway Commission Improvement Program to relieve traffic surrounding the Community College.

Mr. Bell reported that the City of Henderson has awarded the contract for resurfacing city streets to Nevada Rock and Sand Company, which is scheduled to begin immediately. Bids have been received on the Skyline sewer project. Miscellaneous water line extension are under construction.

Mr. Mitton reported that Nevada Power Company is preparing the engineering work order on Bruce Street between Owens Avenue and Las Vegas Boulevard North, and requested information from the City of North Las Vegas on plans.

Mr. Keblinger reported that the Clark County Flood Control is nearing completion of the storm drain project extending from Desert Inn Road on Rome Street to Sierra Vista Drive, East to Maryland Parkway, North on Maryland Parkway to Dumont Street, and East to the Mall next week.

Work is in progress on Rawhide Street where flood damaged an area around the school.

Condemnation of land from Sandhill Road to Duck Creek is under way. Pipe for the crossing at Mt. Vista should arrive within the next month. Installation of pipe at Stephanie and Tropicana will begin in about a week.

Construction of the structure at Nellis Boulevard and East Flamingo Road will probably go to bid within the next three months. A storm drain will also be constructed on Desert Inn Road from Topaz to 1/2 mile West of Eastern Avenue in approximately three weeks.

Plans are available for Rawhide intersection.


Mr. Stay reported that if right-of-way problems are settled, construction should begin in May on Bruce Street between Owens Avenue and Lake Mead Boulevard.

Installation of a short main extension on Washington Avenue from Third Street to Las Vegas Boulevard North is scheduled to begin March 15, 1976.

Mr. Gordon, reported that Central Telephone Company has a major conduit system going in on the East side of Valley View Boulevard from Desert Inn Road to Sirius Street and is scheduled to begin construction April 1, 1976.
