Mayor Briare referred Bill No. 77-10 to a recommending committee consisting of Commissioner Christensen and Commissioner Leavitt.

Commissioner Christensen: I would like to bring something up again in regards to these ordinances. I have been for four years now, 3-1/2 years now, trying to get some kind of a vehicle that would give us the origin of these bills, and I still haven't got it. We've gone over so many different things, and we've got a special sheet that's supposed to go with these new ordinances to indicate who asked for the ordinance and why. I can't understand why it's so hard to get that information. What I'd really like to know about all ordinances that are introduced is that who asked for them and why, because that could satisfy a lot of questions that you have regarding the ordinance. The first thing I see here is this ordinance and I wonder now why do we have to do that and just exactly what does it do. A simple explanation as requested by Regional Streets and Highways by Mayor Briare let's me know that all I have to do is ask somebody on the Regional Streets and Highways and they can answer my question about this ordinance. Without that information, I know nothing. It's that way with every ordinance we come up with, we can never seem to get with a copy of the ordinance, which I have here, but I don't have the cover sheet saying who asked for it, and I never get that cover sheet. I don't really need that cover sheet. All I want to know somewhere on here who asked for it and why. Two questions. Three and a half years I've been trying to get it. We've gone through umpteen different procedures and I still can't seem to find out who and why.

Mayor Briare: On Ordinance 77-11, which is coming up next, you'll find out who and why, but on ordinance 77-10, Mr. Adams could you respond to that and in the future, let's be sure that that is included on the

RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL BY THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS FOR THE LOCATION  
AND DESIGN OF A FEDERAL-AID URBAN HIGHWAY

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WHEREAS, the provisions of NRS 408.100 declare in general terms the policy of the legislature of the state of Nevada and state that for the preservation of the public safety and the promotion of the general welfare, the improvement and development of transportation facilities in the state is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of NRS 408.290 provide that the department may supplement the state highway system by establishing new routes into or in the vicinity of municipalities and metropolitan areas with the approval of the board of county commissioners of the county in which such additions may be proposed and with the approval of the city council of any incorporated city directly affected thereby, if the department determines such additions to be necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Highways has proposed a new route in the county of Clark along a general alignment as shown on the map attached hereto, and more particularly described as a portion of a federal-aid urban highway known as FAU-592, Flamingo Road in Las Vegas, from Eastern Avenue easterly to U.S. 95, a distance of 2.938 miles, more or less; and

WHEREAS, the department has held public hearings pertaining to the location and design of the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the improvement of a portion of said highway as hereinbefore described will be of material benefit to the residents of Clark County and to the public in general by providing a better and safer means of transportation because of such improvement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city commission of the city of Las Vegas, that pursuant to the said NRS 408.290 hereinbefore mentioned, approval is hereby given to the location and design of the hereinbefore-described federal-aid urban highway.

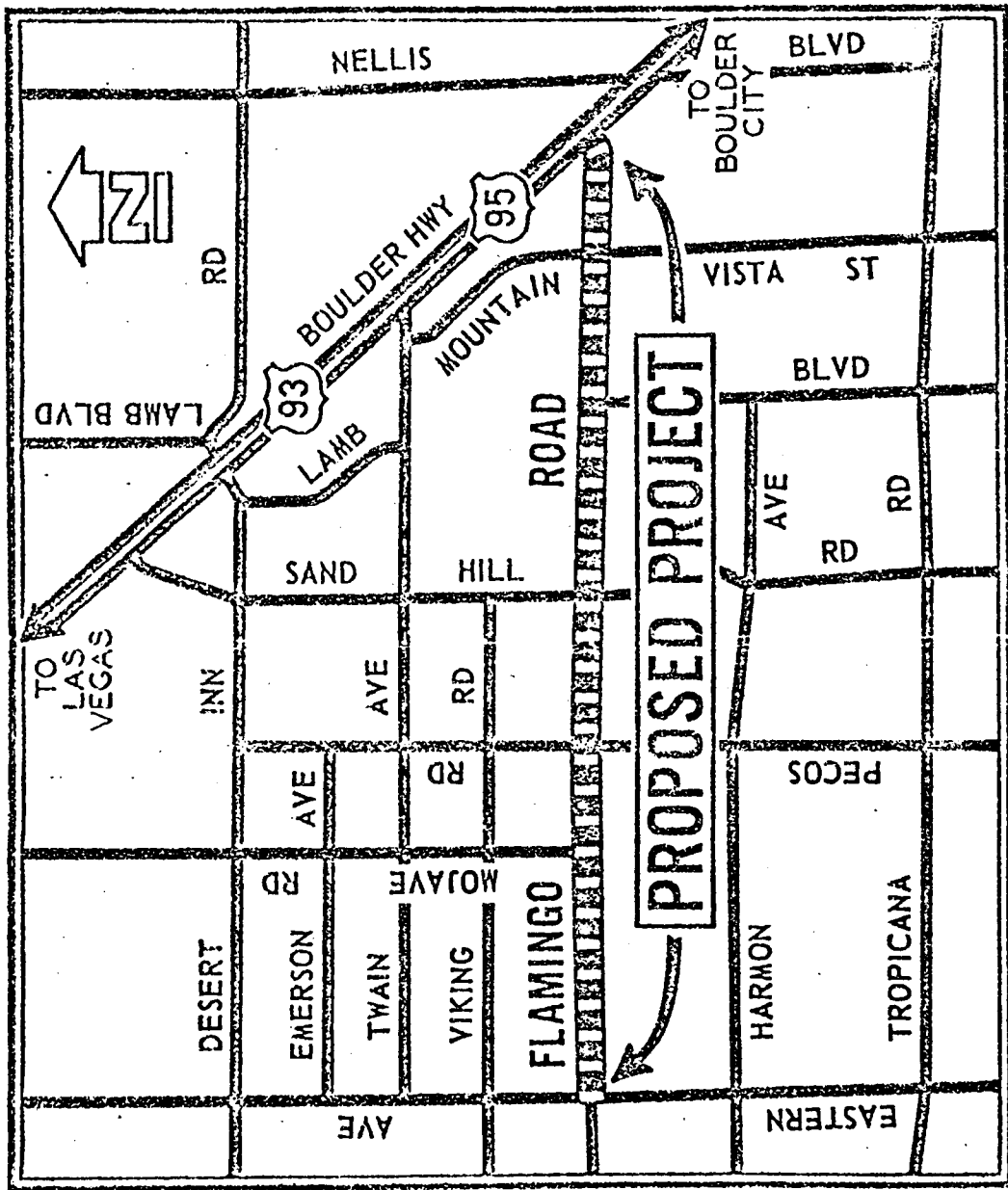
