PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

- F. 1. Request Washington Avenue from Lamb to Nellis be placed on the Regional Transportation Commission priority list.

Rules established this year require requests for streets to be placed on the Regional Transportation Commission priority list originate with the governing body of the requesting entity.

Due to the construction of a flood free underpass and interchange at I-15 and Washington Avenue, plus the widening of Washington from Main to Las Vegas Boulevard North, it is anticipated that the importance of Washington as a major artery will increase greatly.

The construction of Washington between Nellis and Lamb with a bridge across the Las Vegas Wash will complete the East - West street system as planned for the eastern end of Las Vegas. East connections will then be possible with I-15, the downtown area and Nellis Boulevard.

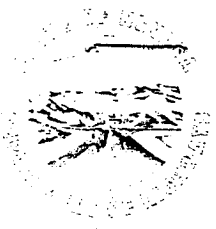
