SUBJECT: DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION CONCERNING FUNDING A MASS TRANSIT SECTION WITHIN THE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND


The Regional Transportation Commission is requesting the individual entities consider funding a mass transit section within the Regional Transportation Commission. The estimated cost for the transit section would be approximately \$100,000. Using a breakdown of population, the City of Las Vegas' contribution would be \$35,300. The funds provided to the Regional Transportation Commission would be utilized for transit promotion for the referendum, as well as allow for negotiations of a purchase of service agreement and provide for possible implementation of portions of the Short Range Transit Plan.

This request is predicated upon the fact that the Regional Transportation Commission is stymied because of a funding source limitation. The gasoline tax can only be used for streets and highways; contributions from the individual entities and grants from the Federal Government are presently providing for the planning section only. There is no funding source for mass transit.

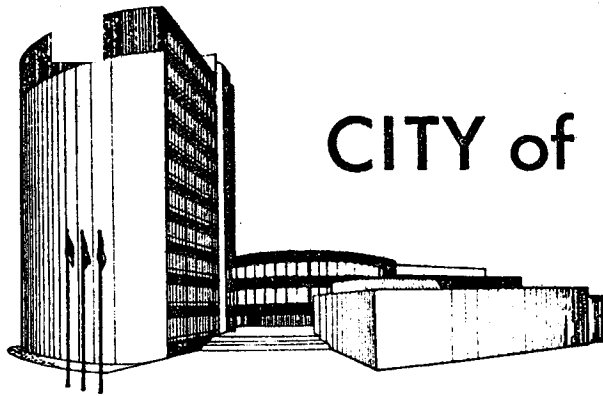

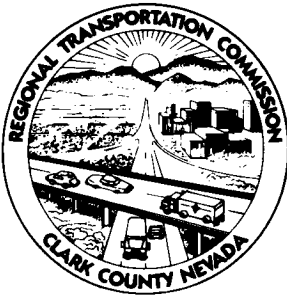
