SUBJECT: REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION PRIORITY LIST FOR SMALL PROJECTS

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

Presently there exists \$1,600,000 of unallocated gas tax funds that are administered by the Regional Transportation Commission.

It is the Regional Transportation Commission Advisory Committee's opinion that high priority small projects should be constructed now to take advantage of the present economic situation in which we are receiving low bids on our construction projects. The Committee fears that, if we postpone construction of these projects, inflation will erode the purchasing power of the dollars we have today.

The following list of traffic signal installation projects are proposed for the City's small projects priority list:

11. Charleston Boulevard and Lamb Blvd. (left-turn phase)	8,500
