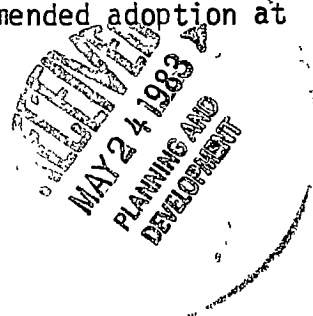

- A. BILL NO. 83-22 - S.I.D. NO. 442, STEP NO. 25-D, ORDINANCE LEVYING ASSESSMENTS, 26 - NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS, IMPROVEMENTS: INCLUDE THE INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTING, CONSISTING OF 100 WATT HIGH-PRESSURE SODIUM LUMINARIES ON STEEL POLES WITH CONCRETE BASES AND UNDERGROUND WIRING, LOCATION: ON PARK PASEO, EIGHTH PLACE AND NINTH STREET FROM FRANKLIN AVENUE TO PARK PASEO.
Committee: Commissioners Christensen and Lurie

No one appeared in opposition to this Bill. Committee recommended adoption at 6/1/83 City Commission meeting.



- B. BILL NO. 83-26 - IMPOSES A 1% ROOM TAX PURSUANT TO SB 170.
Committee: Commissioners Christensen and Lurie

City Attorney George Ogilvie stated this Bill has been amended due to minor changes. No one appeared in opposition. Committee recommended adoption at 6/1/83 City Commission meeting as amended.

- C. BILL NO. 83-27 - ANNEXATION A-4-83(A), PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF WEST CHARLESTON AND RAINBOW, PETITIONED BY: SAVEWAY SUPER SERVICE STATIONS, INC., ACREAGE: 3.73 ACRES, ZONED: R-E (COUNTY CLASSIFICATION) N-U (CITY EQUIVALENT).
Committee: Commissioners Lurie and Christensen

Jack Cason appeared in favor as the owner of Saveway Super Service Stations. No one appeared in opposition. Committee recommended adoption at 6/1/83 City Commission meeting.

- D. BILL NO. 83-28 - PROVIDES THAT OVER-LENGTH VEHICLES MAY BE OPERATED ONLY UPON CERTAIN STREETS OR UPON THOSE STREETS FOR WHICH A TEMPORARY PERMIT HAS BEEN OBTAINED.
Committee: Commissioners Lurie and Christensen

This Bill was inadvertently omitted when the City Code was recodified. Richard Romer of the City of Las Vegas Traffic Department stated they are in favor of this Bill. No one appeared in opposition. Committee recommended adoption at 6/1/83 City Commission meeting.

- E. BILL NO. 83-29 - INCLUDES RUNNING AND BICYCLE MARATHONS IN PARADE ORDINANCE.
Committee: Commissioners Lurie and Christensen

This Bill is to assist the City in providing barricades and personnel for traffic control in running and bicycle marathons. City Attorney George Ogilvie stated there have been minor changes to the original Bill. Committee recommended adoption at 6/1/83 City Commission meeting as amended.
