
WHEREAS, NRS 293.482 authorizes cities and counties within the State of Nevada to seek the advice of voters concerning questions affecting the City by means of advisory ballot question at any general State election or general City election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, at the recommendation of the Council Review Committee established by the Council, desires to seek the advice of voters at the 1999 City general election concerning whether or not to add two wards to the City, with the corresponding addition of two seats on the City Council; and

WHEREAS, NRS 293.482 requires that a proposed advisory question be approved by means of a resolution adopted by the City Council, which sets forth the proposed advisory question, together with other related matters.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the advisory question and related explanations and arguments set forth in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto, are hereby adopted. The City Clerk, City Attorney and other necessary staff are directed to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate in order to include the advisory question and related information on the ballot for the 1999 general City election, in substantially the same form as is set forth in Exhibit "A".
