3 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas,
4 Nevada, by enacting Chapter 4.24 of the Municipal Code of said
5 City, imposed, for the purpose of generating funds with which to
6 finance recreational facilities within the corporate boundaries
7 of said City, an impact fee upon the construction of all apart-
8 ment houses and residential dwelling units that are constructed
9 within said City on and after February 1, 1989; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 80 of said Chapter, the
11 City is divided into 13 park districts, as the same are depicted
12 on the map that is entitled "Park District Boundaries" which is
13 now on file in the Office of the City Clerk and the Department of
14 Parks and Leisure Activities; and

15 WHEREAS, said Section 80 provides that said map may be
16 amended from time to time in order to modify the boundaries of
17 the several park districts by a resolution that is duly passed,
18 adopted and approved by the City Council; and

19 WHEREAS, said City Council has determined, and by this
20 Resolution does so determine, that the boundaries of Park
21 District No. 9 and Park District No. 10, as the same are
22 designated on said map, should be modified by combining the two
23 and making it Park District No. 9 and that said map should be
24 amended accordingly;

25 WHEREAS, said City Council has determined, and by this
26 Resolution does so determine, that Park District No. 11, as the
27 same is designated on said map, should become Park District No.
28 10 and that said map should be amended accordingly;

29 WHEREAS, said City Council has determined, and by this
30 Resolution does so determine, that Park District No. 12 and Park
31 District No. 13, as the same are designated on said map, should
32 be modified by combining the two and making it Park District No.
11 and that said map should be amended accordingly;



1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of
2 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, at its regular meeting thereof
3 that is held on Wednesday, March 21, 1990, that the boundaries of
4 the park districts that have been established pursuant to LVMC
5 4.24.080 and are designated on the map that is provided for in
6 LVMC 2.24.080 and is entitled "Park District Boundaries" be, and
7 they hereby are, modified by combining Park District No. 9 and
8 Park District No. 10 to become Park District No. 9; by changing
9 Park District No. 11 to become Park District No. 10; and by com-
10 bining Park District No. 12 and Park District No. 13 to become
11 Park District No. 11;

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said map be, and the same
13 hereby is, ordered to be amended to reflect such changes; and


14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of said map, as so
