25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND

WHEREAS, The Land and Water Conservation Fund Act was established in 1965 to assist local governments in acquiring, planning and developing land for recreational purposes; and


WHEREAS, the Land and Water Conservation Fund has had a significant impact on our nation's outdoor recreation resources which have greatly contributed to life in this nation; and

WHEREAS, the Land and Water Conservation Fund required states and local governments to prepare comprehensive recreation plans. This requirement has given states and municipalities the impetus to develop new strategies for evaluating needs and opportunities; and





PURPOSE/BACKGROUND
