

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE
MARY'S RIVER LAND EXCHANGE PROPOSAL

1
2 WHEREAS, a land exchange has been proposed which
3 includes an estimated 60,000 acres of private land in Elko County,
4 Nevada within the Mary's River, Humboldt, and Bruneau River
5 drainages and 3,100 acres of public land in the Las Vegas Valley;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, there would be a significant appreciation in
8 the Clark County tax rolls if the presently unproductive BLM land
9 within the City boundaries were to be made productive; and


10 WHEREAS, numerous environmental groups throughout the
11 state have pointed to the historical value of the 60,000 acres of
12 land and the enhanced ability to preserve the wildlife habitat
13 should the exchange be accomplished; and

14 WHEREAS, this exchange would increase the ability of
15 the City to work with the entities involved in the trade process to
16 develop the land as part of the City's master plan process. This
17 exchange would be effective in resolving the fragmented land
18 patterns that currently exists by improving the efficiency in
19 management of both private and public lands;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Las Vegas City
21 Council supports the Mary's River Land Exchange Proposal.
